ENGINEERING FOR PUMPING STATION AND EXTENSION TO ALL AMERICAN ACRES

The irrigation sales report was handed to those present and discussed. Neal Dalton had asked the Board to review his pumping charges, and Dale explained the billing system. Dalton's bill was discussed. The series of letters sent to customers during the season was reviewed. Costs of pumping was discussed. George asked if the extra charges brought a profit to the District and Dale replied the additional charges just brought in what the electrical costs for pumping were. D. L. suggested a letter to the customers explaining more fully the expenses and charges and the fact the District is not making big bucks off this charge.


1990 IRRIGATION SALES REPORT
