## Minutes October 7, 2015

The GSSN met on The GSSN met on Wednesday, Oct. 7, 2015 at the American Legion Hall in Henderson NV. Pres. John Anderson called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM and led in pledging allegiance to the flag. He welcomed all - 59 signed in and there were three visitors. He asked for a motion to approve the September minutes (as posted in the HighGrader) and Fred Zajak made such motion which was seconded by Morris Seguin. Vote was unanimous in approving the motion and it was approved and so carried. Mark Hedges then gave the Treasurer's Report.
