**Mike Golden** is the Director of Chesterfield County's most popular department--Parks & Recreation. He and his 108 full-time and 101 part-time employees manage 49 parks on 4,465 acres, 64 shared use sites on 888 acres, 96 soccer and football fields, 26 picnic shelters and 36.5 miles of trails with an annual \$9.8 million operating budget and \$17.7 million capital improvement funds. There are 27,000 youth sports participants, 6,177 active coaches cards and 4,700,000 park visitors. Mike has been at the helm of this inestimable institution for twelve years and is pioneering his department's preservation, development and interpretation of the County's nationally significant historic sites.
