#### **Adult Day Care:**

Provides relief for families caring for a loved one with dementia or Alzheimer's. This service is available Monday through Thursday from 8:30 AM to 1:30 PM. Lunch and transportation are provided.

#### **Congregate Meals:**

A hot lunch served at the Pickaway Senior Center at 11:30 AM on Monday, and at 12:00 noon Tuesday through Friday.

#### **Homemakers:**

Assistance with cleaning, laundry and running errands. Clients must meet certain eligibility criteria.

#### Meals on Wheels:

A hot lunch delivered to your home five days a week.

# National Family Caregiver Support Program:

Respite and personal care, financial help with co-pays and medicine, utility bills, home repair. The care recipient must be over 60 years of age.

#### **Supportive Services:**

Assistance with Medicare & Medicaid papers, HEAP and Commodities paperwork.

#### **Transportation:**

Transportation for medical appointments, dialysis, and grocery shopping.



#### **HEAP APPLICATIONS AVAILABLE**

The Ohio Development Services Agency wants to remind Ohioans that assistance is available to help with their home energy bills. The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) helps Ohioans at or below 175 percent of the federal poverty guidelines pay their heating bills. Applied directly to the customer's utility or bulk fuel bill, the benefit can help manage heating costs. Ohioans can visit www.energyhelp.ohio.gov to apply online, download a copy of the application or find contact information for a local Energy Assistance Provider (EAP). When applying, individuals need to have copies of the following documents:

- Most recent utility bills./A list of all household members (including birth dates and Social Security numbers).
- Proof of income for the past 30 days for all household members (12 months for certain income types).
- Proof of U.S. citizenship or legal residency for all household members.
- Benefits are applied to an individual's energy bill after January 1st. Applications for the HEAP program must be received by May 31, 2021. For more information call the Center at 740-474-8831.

#### **CONNECTION CAFE**

The Connection Café will feature the Master of Memory program series offered by OSU Extension this May. Are you concerned about memory problems? If so, join us for this 4 part series, *Master of Memory*.


Studies show that 80 percent of older adults complain about memory problems, but only 15 percent report them to their health professional. People of all ages complain about forgetting, but older people tend to worry more about forgetting and memory loss. Regardless of age, memory losses are increased by factors such as inattention, anxiety or depression. Living alone, stress, illness, adapting to the loss of relationships, and the negative stereotypes of society all may affect the older person and their memory.

Master of Memory encourages participants to recognize they can impact their memory function and identify factors that may enhance or detract from their memory function. We will share suggestions that may help address some of those concerns.

OSU Extension will offer The Connection Café on Wednesday mornings at 10 am beginning May 5. These four sessions will be offered online. Sessions will include information on memory strategies, nutrition, medications, medical conditions, and exercise for the body and mind.
