AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES

GREATEST THREAT TO OUR LAKES AT THIS TIME

Zebra and Quagga Mussel Facts:

- They are virtually impossible to eradicate. They have no predator, chemical control DOES NOT WORK.
- Once introduced and established, they can spread rapidly-with one female producing up to a million eggs per year
- Invasive mussels can disrupt food chains, create toxic algae blooms that can kill fish and birds, decrease property values, and reduce recreational enjoyment of natural areas
- They can also cause millions of \$ in damage to water operated infrastructure and clog water supplies to SaskPower facilities, hindering power generation
- Mussels are well established in Manitoba and North Dakota waters as well as areas East and South of both countries. Montana has two reservoirs affected.
