How to Refer a Patient

Referring to us is easy!

- Email or Fax the referral form with <u>ALL requested information</u> to UCPMKreferrals@utmck.edu or (865) 305-4025.
 - Recent Office Notes
 - Current MRI or CT Imaging that focuses on the location of the pain
- We will contact the patient and process the referral

Our Goal (Once we have received all information)

- Contact patient within 48 hours of receipt of referral
- Schedule their consult within 2 weeks of receipt of referral
- Schedule their first procedure within 2 weeks of their scheduled consult

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Is a procedure performed on the first visit?

A: The first visit is a consult <u>only</u> where the provider performs an extensive review of the patient's complaint, history and radiology reports in order to formulate a treatment plan tailored to the patients' needs for the best possible outcome.

Q: What type of imaging is required?

A: Patient should have an MRI or CT that focuses on the location of the pain. The MRI or CT should be within 2 years of the date of the referral. Be sure to have the patient <u>bring their imaging disc to their consult</u>. We are unable to rely only on x-ray reports to make a final diagnosis.

Q: What types of injections do you do?

A: We perform all manner of image guided and non-image guided procedures to address a wide variety of patient complaints. Please see our website at www.ucpmk.com for examples.

Q: What insurance do you take?

A: We accept major insurance groups such as BCBS, Cigna, Humana and United Healthcare. We also accept Medicare and all Medicare supplement insurances. Please look at our website at www.ucpmk.com to see a full list of accepted insurances.

Q: How soon can a patient be seen?

A: Our goal is to schedule the patient within 2 weeks of the referral date. We must have a completed referral form and completed patient paperwork in order to help your patient get relief as soon as possible.
