

#### Construction begins on Automotive Innovation Park... from <u>www.racer.com</u>

A groundbreaking ceremony on Thursday August 20<sup>th</sup> kicked off construction of a 500,000-square-foot **Canadian** industrial facility that will combine a business park with a motorsport road course and testing facilities. The Automotive Innovation Park Oro Station project — expected to provide 700 full-time jobs upon completion — will be home to automotive engineering, education, service, supply and manufacturing businesses. It's also expected to create 1,800 construction jobs.

Oro Station will be home to a 4.1-kilometer/2.5-mile motor circuit — planned for completion in 2022 — for performance testing, training, research and commercial use. In partnership with Georgian College, Oro Station will provide opportunities for students to engage with the automotive industry as it functions as a center for new auto technologies being developed in **Ontario**.

Construction of commercial and industrial buildings is slated to begin in 2021.





We don't have all the details yet, but **save the date**. The details will be provided in the newsletter as soon as possible. It will be fun.




#### Voting:

The news is this: **they won** and then, **they won again**!

#### Road America

On August 2<sup>nd</sup>, Corvette Racing took its second consecutive 1-2 finish in the GT Le Mans (GTLM class) following a chaotic finish. Antonio Garcia and Jordan Taylor won for the second time in their No. 3 Corvette C8.R following a late-race pass in torrential rain.

Oliver Gavin and Tommy Milner placed second in the sister No. 4 Corvette C8.R. It was the eighth victory at Road America for Corvette Racing and the team's first there since 2016.

Things didn't go well, however, in the first half of the race. Taylor led early but the expected tire degradation reduced the pace for the GTLM cars. And electronics issues on the No. 4 Corvette left both Gavin and Milner without traction control.

Rain came with an hour to go. Officials halted the race with 43 minutes left. The rain let up initially before cars returned to the track with about 25 minutes to go. Following final pit stops for wet tires, racing resumed with seven minutes left and Garcia in second place.

An even more intense rain began to fall with just minutes left race. Garcia was locked in a back-and-forth duel with the No. 911 Porsche before two competitors went off-track late in the lap.

Both Garcia and Milner were able to get through the chaos and took the

checkered flag under a race-ending, fullcourse caution.

#### Virginia International Raceway (VIR)

In the midst of one of its hottest streaks of racing during the last few seasons, Corvette Racing *won again* on August 23 at VIR! Antonio Garcia and Jordan Taylor drove the No. 3 Corvette C8.R to victory, despite having to carry an additional 20kg of weight per updated BoP guidelines. This race was their second win in a row, their third of the season and the fourth consecutive win for Corvette Racing – the first time that's happened for the team since 2014.

Bad luck hit the No. 4 Corvette, going off-track shortly after a restart when Oliver Gavin picked up debris on his tires just an hour into the race. He recovered nicely and carved his way back and was behind the No. 3 Corvette in only seven laps. He stopped for fuel, tires and driver change to Tommy Milner with 65 minutes to go. The No. 4 would end the race with a 4<sup>th</sup> place finish.

Antonio Garcia in the No. 3 Corvette took the lead with 18 minutes remaining but was worried by a flapping diffuser in the final run to the checkered flag. It held on, though, giving Garcia/Taylor the victory by 3.521 seconds! During the race, others went off the track or had tire issues," said Jordan Taylor. "I think it's just a staple of Corvette Racing of never giving up."

Up next is Road Atlanta on Sept. 5.




