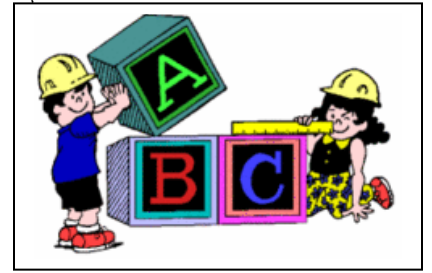


Angel Academy Curriculum:

*The following curriculum is what the 4-6 year olds will be introduced to. The 3 year olds will do some of the same, not all of the following.



Basic Concepts:

- Identify colors, basic shapes and sizes.
- Compare and describe the sizes and lengths of different objects.
- Classify objects according to common attributes.
- Understand the concept of opposites (in/out, up/down).
- Understand positional concepts (behind, beside, between).
- Develop and practice fine motor skills by coloring, cutting, gluing and manipulating objects.

Letters and sounds:

- Recognize and form the 26 upper and lower case letters of the alphabet.
- Introduce the sound each letter of the alphabet makes.

Reading readiness:

- Note similarities and differences among pictures.
- Follow directional paths from left to right and top to bottom.
- Form pre-writing strokes.
- Recall the sequence of a story.
- Learn to predict outcomes.
- Form the correct strokes to write first and last names.
- Recognize and write the numerals 0-10.
- Count objects and sets of objects through 10.
- Recite numerals 0-10 in Spanish.

Mathematics Readiness:

- Match objects one to one.
- Develop concepts about quantity (more/fewer).
- Describe a simple sequence of events (before/after).
- Describe events using ordinal numbers (first, second, third).

Social and emotional development:

- Instill manners through stories, role play and work sheets.
- Learn independence and self-control, taking turns, following directions and patience.
- Learn how to participate and cooperate in-group settings.
