Ans- The claws of eagles are strong and, sharp and curved which help them to hold the prey firmly.

- 3) What does the woodpecker use its beak for?

Ans- The woodpecker has a long, chisel-like beak. It taps and makes holes in tree-trunks in search of insects. Its long, sticky tongue pulls out insects and worms.
