



Musician Responsibilities

1. Qualifications

Musicians may participate in the Southwest Washington Wind Symphony (SWWS) by the invitation of the Board of Directors. Musicians shall be invited based upon their musical competence, professionalism, commitment to the goals of the organization, and needed instrumentation as determined by the music and conductor.

2. Conditions of Participation

Musicians are expected to:

- a. Be prompt, punctual, and attend all rehearsals and concerts unless previously **arranged** with the personnel manager, Jim O'Banion.
- b. Stay home when ill and get well! Please contact Jim O'Banion at jimobanion@comcast.net or text to ph. (503) 791-7920 to notify SWWS of your absence.
- c. Upon knowledge of a second **unarranged** rehearsal absence, the personnel manager may refer the issue to the SWWS Board for review.
- d. Have music prepared for each rehearsal.
- e. Be responsible for any sheet music received and return it at the conclusion of a concert series. The performing musician is financially responsible for lost music.
- f. Please refrain from wearing cologne, aftershave, or perfumes as others may be sensitive or allergic.
- g. Please demonstrate courtesy and respect to all participants and contribute to the SWWS culture of musical excellence, professionalism, and community.
