X-12 Hillclimb Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Can I camp at the hill? Yes. The event gates open at 2PM on Thursday, May 1. Racers can camp at the hill at no cost, (in the pits only). Non-racers can camp at the event for \$25 per vehicle and camp in the camping area (not the pits). Racers who want to camp in the camping area (rather than the pits) may do so for a \$25 fee. There are also, 19, front-row, reserved VIP camp spots available on the website. This is private property, so NO ORV stickers are needed.
- 2. Will there be a tuning area for racers to tune their bikes? Yes.
- **3.** Are dogs allowed at this event? Yes, as long as they are leashed, well-behaved, and their owners clean up after them. Do NOT let your dog run around free.
- 4. Are campfires allowed? Yes, as long as they are NOT on the ground. Fires may only be built in a fire box or a BBQ. And NO guns or fireworks. There will be porta-toilets and food at the event of course.
- 5. When does racer registration end? Registration for the five Pro classes will close at midnight on April 28. Online registration for all of the trophy and semi-pro classes closes on Thursday, May 1 at 8pm, and onsite (at the event) Saturday, May 3 at 10am, (cash or check only).
- 6. Will there be awards at the event? Yes. Trophies, (kids get 100% trophies and adult amateur classes get 33% trophies), pro cash and Rockwell Watches will also be given out at the end of each day of competition.
- 7. If it rains will the event be cancelled or rescheduled? Oh heck no. This is hillclimbing and it runs rain or shine. We are adding some additional gravel to the road leading to the pro pits. The rest of the road has plenty of gravel in case of rain.
- 8. Will food and t-shirts be for sale at the event? Yes, absolutely.
- 9. One of my buddies said that pit racing is NOT allowed this year. That is correct. This is a hillclimb and we have got to stop kids on minis and 4-wheelers from buzzing around all day kicking up dust and risking someone getting hurt. If you bring a 4-wheeler, use it to get to the starting line or spectator area. Do NOT bring mini bikes unless you have kids competing on them.
