Frederick R. Volz, 69, of Sebewaing died Tuesday evening, Feb. 1, 2000, at Lakeland Regional Medical Center in Lakeland, Fla., following a two-and-a-half year illness. He was born June 27, 1930, in Bay City, son of the late Ruben E. and Martha H. (Bendler) Volz. He was united in marriage to Margaret A. Anderson in Dec. 28, 1950, in Pigeon.
