## Permission to Enter / Do Not Enter

The Morris Police Department checks businesses for security as frequently as possible when they are closed. There are times when we may find doors or windows unsecure. If this occurs, officers will check for evidence of forced entry. In the absence of forced entry, it is not lawful for officers to make a search of your property without your permission. The department will call you or a designated keyholder any time we find your business unsecure.

## Flock OS Participation

The Morris Police Department has a software program called FlockOS. FlockOS is a cloud based public safety platform. With FlockOS, officers are equipped with real-time information to improve situational awareness and efficiency. A feature of the program allows business information and floor plans to be uploaded and readily available to officers.

Morris Police Department is requesting your assistance in improving officer awareness and efficiency. We are looking for copies of floor plans for businesses that can be uploaded into our mapping system as well as any other pertinent information officers can use. Examples of when your floor plan would be used include burglary alarms, active shooters, bomb threats, disturbances, even fires and medical calls. The floor plans give officers an idea what to expect when they enter the building and possible hazards. This information is visible only to law enforcement officers, fire/EMS personnel and the dispatch center.
