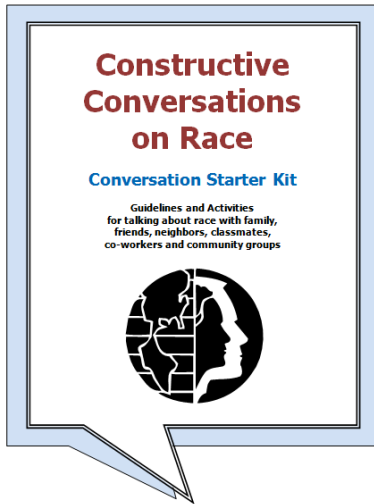

Such conversations, which work well in cross-congregational settings, have been occurring in Springfield for the last 19 months.

Initiated by the Springfield Race Unity Committee and endorsed by the Springfield Ministerial Alliance and the Greater Springfield Interfaith Association, **Constructive Conversations on Race** is a proven program that has led to many healthy, non-accusatory discussions on race, and to a significant number of inter-racial/-congregational friendships that are continuing to blossom across the Springfield area.
