## 1930-1994

Francis A. Schnitker, 64 of Sebawaing, passed away Thursday, June 23, at St. Mary's Hospital, Saginaw, following a short illness.

He was born in Pigeon on April 29, 1930, a son of the late George and Baldina (Schultze) Schnitker. He was a graduate of Pigeon High School, Class of 1949.
