

DESCRIPTION: Proline was a highly regarding Michigan bow company. They did considerable work with Shakespeare during the 1960's and 70's. Some of their bows were branded as Shakespeare Proline, such as the Osprey, Condor, and Eaglet models. Proline considered by some as a direct descendant of Shakespeare. Proline continued after Shakespeare closed down its archery division in 1976. This Proline Attila performs well, just like Shakespeare bows do. Factory installed stabilizer bushing. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. There are three (3) small sight/quiver bushings on the side of the riser. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decals are in excellent condition. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent minty condition for its age.
