COVID-19 Guideline Recommendations

We should all be thankful that, with rare exceptions, COVID-19 is not claiming the lives of our children. However, we can never forget that a child with a mild or even asymptomatic case of COVID-19 can spread that infection to others who may be far more vulnerable. Parents should monitor the health of their children and not send them to camp if they exhibit any symptom of COVID-19.

Health Recommendations for Lakeview Camp Employees and Volunteers

- Train all staff on appropriate cleaning and disinfection, hand hygiene, and respiratory etiquette.
- Provide notice to parent or guardian that they may choose to either pick up their camper or to let camper remain and trust the camp to take appropriate safeguards when informed by the camp operator that a child or adult has tested positive.
- All staff and volunteers shall be screened daily for any of the following signs or symptoms of possible COVID-19: cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, fever, known contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19.
- Staff shall wear face coverings properly and maintain 6 feet of social distancing from camper while indoors.
- Staff shall follow and supervise cabin hygiene plan, dining hygiene plan, and program activity plan

Health Recommendation for Adult Sponsors and Campers

- Daily health screening will be required of all campers (students and adults) on day of arrival and each subsequent day of camp.
- Any camper or sponsor that becomes sick will be isolated and then sent home as soon as possible
- For health precautions, outside visitors are not allowed
- Hand sanitizers will be located at several locations throughout the camp
- Proper wearing of mask and social distancing is encouraged while attending indoor activities

Dining hygiene Plan

- Wearing of mask through serving lines is mandatory
- Sanitizing hands before going through serving lines is mandatory
- Non-disposable food service items will be washed and sanitized in dishwasher after each use.
- Camp staff will clean and disinfect tables, chairs, etc. after each use.

Cabin Hygiene Plan

- Handwashing and/or hand sanitizing should be as frequent as possible
- Dorms will be cleaned and sanitized after each camp or as needed
- Campers are encouraged to sleep head to toe in lower and upper bunks
- Personal fans should be pointed at one camper only.

Program Activity Plan

- Hand washing and/or hand sanitizing before and after activities
- Sanitization of program areas will be done
- Sanitization of equipment before and after use
