Anna M. Walsh, 94 of Pigeon, passed away Sunday morning, June 9 at the Huron County Medical Care Facility, Bad Axe.

She was born Feb. 17, 1902 in Alpena, daughter of the late James and Anna (McGlorey) Doyle. She was united in marriage to Mike Walsh on May 28, 1938 in Detroit. He preceded her in death on Sept. 9, 1975.
