The cuts to fire departments, ambulance districts and our law enforcement would be detrimental. The Commission has contacted Legislatures to ask them to not support this bill.

The Commission and Clerk are continuing to work on annual goals for the Road & Bridge Department as well as the Maintenance Department at the Courthouse.

An open house will be held at Sunset Home in the Spring with all patrons being invited to attend.

University of Missouri Extension Engagement Specialist, Gina Lucas met with the Commission to give them an update on what work the Extension was doing in DeKalb County and the number of children involved with 4-H. Although the Extension has had a presence in DeKalb County the Commission is grateful the office is back in Maysville and very thankful for all of the parents and people involved in 4-H and the Extension.

With no other business before the Commission, West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to adjourn until March 7, 2023. Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll made the second to adjourn.
