David M. Renn, 52, of Portland, Oregon and formerly of Elkton, died Thursday, September 25, 2003, at Portland Hospital following a short battle with lung cancer. He was born October 29, 1950 in Bad Axe to Harry and Marilyn (Kanyak) Renn. David grew up in Elkton and was a 1968 graduate of Elkton-Pigeon-Bay Port High School.
