## TENTATIVE Schedule for WHITE PILLAR TERRACE – Phase 2 Repairs & Parking Closures:

### Monday, June 1 - FIRST Half of White Pillar from Marsh Point Court entrance of White Pillar up to the curve

- All vehicles must be removed from White Pillar as designated above either
  - the evening of May 31 or
  - **before 6:45 am, June 1**
  - vehicles not removed before 6:45 am June 1 will be towed.
- You can park in the Pool Parking lot or on Rolling Fork Way (where legally allowable) starting Sunday evening, May 31.
- NO PARKING allowed on the White Pillar designated area until Thursday, June 4 when the caution tape and cones are removed by the HOA Board or Contractor.

### **Thursday, June 4**

Note – you can *resume parking on White Pillar* **ONLY in your 2 new reserved spaces.** Please note that the space marked Visitor is for short-term visitor parking only and not intended for residential long-term parking.

### Monday, June 8 - SECOND Half of White Pillar from the Rolling Fork Way entrance to White Pillar before Primrose View Court up to the curve

- All vehicles must be removed from White Pillar as designated above either
  - the evening of June 7 or
  - **before 6:45 am, June 8**
  - vehicles not removed before 6:45 am June 8 will be towed.
- You can park in the Pool Parking lot or on Rolling Fork Way (where legally allowable) starting Sunday evening, June 7.
- NO PARKING allowed on the White Pillar designated area until Thursday, June 11 when the caution tape and cones are removed by the HOA Board or Contractor.

### **Thursday, June 11**

Note – you can *resume parking on White Pillar* **ONLY in your 2 new reserved spaces.** Please note that the space marked Visitor is for short-term visitor parking only and not intended for residential long-term parking.

Vehicles not removed from White Pillar by 6:45 am, on the designated date  
will be towed at the owner's expense.
