EDITOR'S NOTES

For many years there has been a growing need for a cumulative index of the Society publications. The task of compilation was made unusually difficult because of discrepancies in the issue numbering system and dates that were often erratic. This index list attempts to correct the irregularities. Those who have a complete set will need to make some corrections on their copies. Each publishing year was assigned a new volume number. Many articles do not indicate their authors. Issue editors in the Smoke Signals were not identified and articles were of a general nature rather than of scientific nature. No formal format was followed because it was meant to be an interesting, highly readable news letter.

We salute the Sheridan Chapter for their pioneering efforts and the present State Society is the direct result of a meeting of six people on a wintery evening, February 4, 1953, in the lovely home of Fred and Elaine Hilman at Big Horn, Wyoming. Present were Dr. Ray Bentzen, John McClintock, Pauline McIntosh, and Margaret Powers. And how it has grown!

The Index Edition, Carlton Belz of the Casper Chapter, volunteered to compile an index and, with his expected thoroughness, ended up with an Issue on Authors, on Articles, a Category Index along with a final Site Index. Overwhelmed with all this, I asked for a cumulative Index, combining all the above features. John Albanese added the date following volume and issue numbers, thus the index became a reality. Carlton suggests making the following corrections to your copies:

- 1. The first issue of the Archaeologist should be marked Vol. II, Number 3 and 4, dated April and May 1959.
- 2. The January 1962 issue (printed Vol. IV, No. 1) should be Vol. V, No. 1.
- 3. The March 1962 (printed Vol. V, No. 1) should be Vol. V, No. 1A. The publication then assumed a quarterly printing date for the remainder of 1962.
- 4. The Spring 1964, No. 1 (printed Vol. VIII) should be Vol. VII.
- The Winter 1964, No. 4 (printed Vol. VIII) should be Vol. VII.

Also articles by an author list first the surname followed by the given name. Reprinted articles list first the given name followed by the surname.
