What an activity packed (and my favorite) month we have! First week of the month is our Fall "Let's Get Together" breakfasts. Mr. Kelly puts on quite a spread for our families to enjoy the first meal of the day with their children, in their own classrooms. It is also a great opportunity to get to know your children's teachers better, your child's classmates and their family members! Please plan on joining us. If you've missed out on this one, there will be another in the middle of February.

We will also be sending home your child's **Original** art**Works**. This is a small fundraiser for us but it is also a chance to get some memorable artwork recreated on different items for you to cherish, give us gifts, etc. You will look back on these for years (I still drink coffee out of a coffee cup adorned from artwork made 20+ years ago, from my oldest). Be on the lookout for more information soon.

Additionally, from October 8th—26th, Sandia National Laboratories will be holding their annual Sandia Gives campaign. PLEASE keep La Luz ECC in mind. We are not a direct United Way funded organization, but we do receive your monthly (or one time) gifts pledged during this time. They also help us continue to add more employee benefits, and SO much more. We are a 501(c)3, not for profit corporation. All you have to do is designate SSTPS, Inc. (SSTPS is our legal name) or SSTPS, Inc. DBA La Luz Early Childhood Center. Either one will come to us. We operate almost exclusively on tuition collected from our families. We try not to do too many fundraisers as they are exhausting for us and for you. This is really our largest source of fundraising for the entire year, so we'd like thank all of you for your kindness and generosity in advance!!

Our next Grown Up's Night Out will be on Saturday, October 13th from 4pm to 10pm. Sign up sheets will be going up soon. My emails with more information on this will be forthcoming.

Finally, our annual Fall Carnival will be held on Thursday, October 25th from 3 to 5pm. A different activity is set up in each class (and sometimes the playgrounds, weather permitting) with the exception of the Infant Room. It is just too overwhelming to have all the people in and out of that class for our littlest ones, plus, some of the costumes can be scary for them. Also, please do **NOT** send your child in costume that day. We will gladly change them for you or you are welcome to come in and do it before the festivities begin.
