1. Call to Order- Francie
2. President's Report - Francie
  - Schedule of Meetings - see schedule below
3. Treasurer's Report Jeannine
  - Budget - we have about \$206k in the bank right now which is similar to what we had at this time last year.
  - Taxes - filed an extension until about May
  - Fees
  - Expenses - a little over \$6 k for teacher items and \$2700 for color printers and some administrative costs.
4. Secretary's report - Abby (filling in for Tricia)
  - **Action: Approval of October meeting minutes**
5. Principal's Report Dr. Schmidt
  - Virtual assembly coming up for Veteran's day and the one for First Responders went well. Ambassadors will be involved and USO might do a performance.
  - Crossing guard passed away - memorial - Angela Bantley and Lisa Searles in charge of it, gathering at Piedmont Lot on Thursday to walk and cross over to table with vases for flowers and notes or cards. His family will be present
  - Parent-Teacher conferences, Los Al @ Home, Monday and Tuesday after school and Wednesdays for Hybrid traditional. No students on campus on a Wednesday until December.
  - Coding Month - Kids will have an opportunity to learn Scratch or Scratch Jr and implementing Raspberry Pi, Lego WeDo, and Robots. They will need to complete levels of coding to get access to different items.
6. Raspberry Pi/Lego WeDo Report Laura Hall
  - Coding Month - November and December since November has two holidays
    - 5 lessons. First set is recorded. Laura is doing 4/5 grade Scratch and Raspberry Pi lessons
    - Mrs. Chicarelli - K thru 3 Scratch Jr.
    - Claudia - Lego We Do Kits will be handed out 3 weeks at a time.
    - Needs volunteers to help clean up the kits a bit
    - Laura thinks that the WeDos should go down to 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and Dr. Schmidt said that is fine.
7. Teacher's Report - Mrs. Otani
  - We have reimbursed all of the teachers for their expenses with the exception of one long-term sub.
  - Mrs. Otani was in parent-teacher conferences.
8. Family Fun Nights: Jackie and Christine O. & Gina
  - Name Change to Dining for Dollars?

- Jackie Aker – Dining for dollars instead of Family Fun Night because it does not necessarily apply only to night and people are not just going out but staying in.
  - Blaze Pizza – successful event. They are willing to do these more frequently. It would have to be Monday or Tuesday.
  - November 16 – Both Chipotle and Yogurtland
  - November 24 – Wahoo’s
  - 12/11/20 – Cookie Kits – Suzie Q bakery will do holiday cookie kit – 6 cookies with toppings and fixings for \$20 per kit and she will give 25% back to the school. All orders will need to be in by 12/7/20 and then distribute Friday. Payment – may be better to do bidpal because those people who do not pay up front no-show. Maybe charge \$25 for credit card and \$20 for venmo. Make it mandatory to pay up front. Dr. Schmidt suggested doing bidpal to avoid complications and then cut a check to Suzie Q.
  - Blaze Pizza Fundraiser – raised almost 1k from weaver and 2k including the other schools. Discussed teachers and full-time staff receiving the credit/certificate for free pizza. Dr. Schmidt wants to make sure that full-time staff and teachers, such as SDC, Tyler, Wendy, etc, all receive the benefit.
9. Gala Report/Discussion: Christine O. Christine C. and Tracy
- Old Ranch Contract
  - Raffle Items, Wine, Yeti
  - Some ideas for how to handle these – People who bought wine pull tickets. Maybe for everyone who purchased the higher packages, would get a couple of raffle opportunities.
  - Is it worth going to the trouble of trying to sell more raffle tickets or is better to give the selected with a deadline for when to select raffle items.
  - Will hold off on opportunity tickets until 2021, will work on distributing wine from the wine pull by the holidays in 2020.
  - Will look into converting the ticket sale into a cash donation.
  - Old Ranch (OR) is allowing us to apply to cost so long as it is within the same calendar year. Will keep trying to defer the deposit from Mar 2020 event forward. Will hold off on reserving the Friday, 10/30/2021 date.
  - There is a lot to discuss here – will continue the conversation as a board-only working group.

11. Other Busines – Forward funding. The district is asking for the forward funding early. We have concerns about ability to fund raise for 2022-2023 school year and what school will look like in the Fall of 2021 (will we still be some form of hybrid/COVID protocols). Francie and Christine C. will meet with Dr. Schmidt and Mrs. Otani to discuss forward funding and STEAM instruction.
