The WE Rules governing this show are the United States Rules for Working Equitation, Revision 1, dated 1 December 2017. The Rulebook, including dressage tests and obstacle descriptions, may be found at [www.confederationwe.us](http://www.confederationwe.us) or at [www.erahc.org](http://www.erahc.org). **It is important that all competitors read the rules before competing.** If you have any questions regarding the rules or any requirements in this Prize List, please contact the Show Manager.

**All competitors holding an individual membership with the Confederation or who are members of a Group Member (GM) organization may compete. Non-members are allowed to compete for a \$30 non-member fee. (OPPORTUNITY CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM THIS FEE). ERAHC is a Group Member of the Confederation (GM-006), so all ERAHC members are group members of the Confederation.**

**Competitors interested in being eligible for lifetime medal awards and year-end awards with the Confederation must hold individual memberships.**

**\*\*\*ALL COMPETING HORSES MUST BE RECORDED WITH THE CONFEDERATION IN ADVANCE OF THE SHOW. A one-time fee of \$20 per horse includes lifetime performance tracking for Confederation events. NOT REQUIRED FOR THE OPPORTUNITY CLASSES.**

### Payment Policy

- **Make checks payable to ERAHC.** No refunds after closing date. Refunds will be granted at the sole discretion of ERAHC and show management.
- **Checks returned for non-sufficient funds** will be assessed a \$25 fee by ERAHC for each occurrence.
- **No entry may show unless it is paid in full** or the entry is guaranteed with an open check or cash deposit. Management may require cash deposit from any entry who has an outstanding balance with ERAHC, or who has had past payments returned

### Entry Procedures

- Use the Confederation Entry Form for all WE classes.
  - Entry form is included as attachment to this Prize List and can also be found on ERAHC’s website: [www.erahc.org](http://www.erahc.org)
- An entry form is not valid unless it is fully completed and has all the proper signatures, membership numbers, and horse information. Each entry form must have the original (not copies) signatures of Riders/Handlers, the Owner/Agent, and the Trainer. An adult must sign for any junior rider.
- Mail **entry forms and fees** to the **Show Secretary**. Entries must be postmarked by the closing date; entries postmarked after the closing date will be assessed a **\$50** late fee and possibly be placed on a waiting list.

- No phone entries will be accepted. Entries are accepted on a first-paid, first-served basis.
- **The Confederation uses the same qualifications for Amateur Riders as the USEF. So please know these rules.**
- **Child exhibitors** must be between **8-13** at any time during the current year. Child exhibitors must indicate their date of birth on the entry form.
- Photocopy of negative **Coggins** test, dated within one year of the end of the show must accompany the entry form. Entries without a current (valid through show date) **Coggins** test result will not be accepted. The state of Pennsylvania requires a **Health Certificate** for any horse arriving from out of state.
- Any **non-competing horses** must have an entry form sent in with a current negative **Coggins** test.

### Prizes/Awards

- Rosettes awarded from 1<sup>st</sup> thru 5<sup>th</sup> place in each class **for Open and Amateur divisions.**
- Championship and Reserve Championship rosettes will be awarded to the overall first and second place rider/horse teams in each level/division (must show in all phases of the level/division to qualify).
- All Champions will be awarded prizes.

### Stabling Details

- Pennsylvania law requires a current **health certificate** for horses arriving from out of state. Your horse cannot be stabled on the grounds without a health certificate.
- Competitors may show out of their trailer. There will be a **\$25 charge.**
- **Arrival:** Friday, July 19, 2019 after 3:00 p.m.
- **Departure:** Monday, July 22, 2019 by 8:00 a.m.
- **Early arrivals/late departures** must be coordinated with and approved by the **Stable Manager**, and will be subject to an additional **\$50 charge per stall per day.**
- Emergency contact information must be prominently displayed on all stalls housing an animal, including both cell phone and local contact information.
- **Do not use stalls you have not paid for.**

### General Information

- ERAHC reserves the right to refuse an entry for any reason.
- ERAHC, the ERAHC Working Equitation Show, and Birchtown Stables reserve the right to maintain a **Harassment Free Environment** and may remove or refuse entry to any person(s) disrupting the show.
- **Proper attire** will be required of all exhibitors in the show ring.
- **Dogs** must be securely tied, caged, in a closed stall, or on a leash at all times while on the show grounds or in the stable area. **No Dogs** allowed in the indoor arena.
- **No smoking** is allowed in the barn areas or in any of the other buildings.

**From Clarks Summit / Scranton/ I-81 South :** Take I-81 North to Exit 202 (Tompkinsville/ Fleetville Exit). Turn Right onto PA 107 South/East Towards Heart Lake, Go 3-4 Miles to Stop Sign (At Heart Lake) Turn Left onto 247 North, Go 6 Miles to Second Blinking Light at Dundaff, Turn Right onto 247 North, Go 1.5 Miles to Crystal Lake on Right, Turn Left onto 247 North, Follow for 1 Mile to Stop Sign, Go Straight onto PA-2023 towards Uniondale, Birchtown Stables is 1.5 Miles on the Left.

**Directions From South/Wilkes-Barre:** Take I-81 North, merge on to US-6/ Casey Highway Exit 187 towards Carbondale. Take Exit 5 / Jermyn 107. Turn left off Exit on to PA 107. Follow for 5 Miles. Turn Right on to PA 247 at Heart Lake. Follow 6 miles. Turn right at blinking light on to 247. Follow 1.5 miles, Turn left at Crystal Lake on to 247. Go straight at stop. 1.5 miles on left.

**Directions From West/Honesdale:** Follow US-6 West through Waymart, Turn right on to Canaan St. / Carbondale Exit 7. Take first right on to Canaan/Railroad Street. At stop make Left on to 1003 Reservoir Road. Follow to bottom, make right on to Rt. 171. About 1 mile, turn slight left on to 1011 Owego Turnpike (up hill). Follow for 3 miles. Turn right on to Rt. 247, by Crystal Lake. Go straight through stop sign towards Union Dale On 2023. 1.5 miles on left.

**Directions From North/Upstate New York:** Take Interstate 81 South to Exit 206 (PA - 374 Exit towards Lenoxville). Exit Fast Approaches! Turn left off exit on to PA-374E, proceed 2 Miles till Stop sign. Turn Right onto PA - 106 East, follow till Yellow Bling Light, Make Left onto Airport Road. Follow up hill till Stop Sign, Turn Left. Follow till Yellow Blinking Light and make a right turn on to PA 247 North go about 1.5 miles (Crystal Lake) make a left on to PA 247 north. Go one mile to stop sign, notice Panorama Golf course on your left side. Continue straight thru onto PA 2023 north towards Union Dale. Proceed about one mile and Birchtown Stables is on your left hand side.

**Directions from I-84 from New York/New Jersey :** Take Exit 8 onto PA-247 towards Mt Cobb. Turn Right off of Exit onto PA-247. At Intersection go Straight through. In 4 miles bear to the Right to Stay on PA-247. At bottom of hill Turn Right to merge onto US-6 E towards Carbondale. Take Exit 5 / Jermyn 107. Turn left off Exit on to PA 107. Follow for 5 Miles. Turn Right on to PA 247 at Heart Lake. Follow 6 miles. Turn right at yellow blinking light on to 247. Follow 1.5 miles, Turn left at Crystal Lake on to 247. Go straight at stop. 1.5 miles on left.

**RELEASE:**

I understand that this is a high-risk sport and I am participating at my own risk. I hereby assume this risk and further do hereby release and hold harmless the organizer (Licensee), organizing committee, competition management, judges and officials; the Confederation for Working Equitation (the "Confederation"), its officers, agents, employees and volunteers; the host of this event or competition; and the owners of any property on which the event or competition is being held, from all liability for negligence resulting in accidents, damage, injury, or illness to myself and to my property, including the horse or horses that I will compete at this event or competition.

**CONFEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT:**

By entering a Confederation-endorsed competition and signing this entry form as the Owner, Rider, or Parent/Guardian, I agree that I am subject to and agree to be bound by the Bylaws of the Confederation applicable to the Confederation-endorsed competition, the U.S. Rules for Working Equitation ("Rules"), and the requirements of the competition as stated in the Prize List. I will accept as final the decision of the Protests Committee or Appeals Committee on any question arising under the Rules and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Confederation, their officials, directors, and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Confederation and/or competition management may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage, or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Confederation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The Confederation is governed by the laws and the State of Texas; any action instituted against the Confederation must be filed in Texas State.

In consideration for my participation in this Competition, **I AGREE to the following:**

- I AGREE that the Confederation and the Competition as used herein include the Licensee and competition management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, and Confederation affiliates.
- I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse as a rider, owner, or parent/guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").
- I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Confederation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Confederation or the Competition.
- I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Confederation or the Competition.
- I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Confederation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition I have read the Rules about protective equipment (Article 1.9.1.i) and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty. I acknowledge that the Confederation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching, and abilities to safely compete in this competition. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation, AGREE to all of the above provisions, and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf. I understand and AGREE that all competitors under the age of 18 must wear an ASTM/SEI-approved safety helmet.
- I AGREE that if I am injured at this Competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Confederation and competition management.
