

Bloomfield Police Department

Monthly Report for March 2020

This is the monthly report for the Month of March 2020 from the Bloomfield Police Department. It is the police department's goal to keep the citizens of Bloomfield Township/Village informed as to the police department's activities, statistics, and community projects. It is very important that the citizens be aware of the various concerns that have and are occurring within our community.

On Saturday, March 7th at approximately 8:36pm officers responded to a residence in the 900 block of Iris Ave for an unwanted subject complaint. At the conclusion of the investigation a 54-year-old male was arrested and confined in the Walworth County Jail. A charge of bail jumping has been forwarded to the Walworth County District Attorney's office.

On Saturday, March 14th at approximately 12:07am officers located a suspicious vehicle parked in the parking lot of a closed business on Powers Lake Road. At the conclusion of the investigation a 19-year-old female was issued a non-traffic citation for trespass to land and an 18-year-old male was issued non-traffic citations for possession of marijuana and trespass to land.

On Wednesday, March 18th at approximately 10:51pm officers responded to 600 block of N2020 Hwy H for a loud noise complaint. At the conclusion of the investigation a 34-year-old male was arrested and confined in the Walworth County Jail. Charges of disorderly conduct, criminal damage to property and possession of drug paraphernalia have been forwarded to the Walworth County District Attorney's office.

On Saturday, March 21st at approximately 8:03am officers responded to the 600 block of N2020 Hwy H for a bail jumping complaint. At the conclusion of the investigation a charge of bail jumping was forwarded to the Walworth County District Attorney's office for a 34-year-old male who fled the area prior to officer's arrival.

On Saturday, March 28th at approximately 2:56am officers responded to a residence in the 1500 block of Overlook Drive for a domestic disturbance. At the conclusion of the investigation a 42-year-old male was arrested then confined in the Walworth County Jail. Charges of battery, disorderly conduct, and criminal damage to property were forwarded to the Walworth County District Attorney's office.

On Saturday, March 28th at approximately 9:51am officers responded to a residence in the 1400 block of Eastwood Road for a domestic disturbance. At the conclusion of the investigation a 34-year-old female was arrested and confined in the Walworth County Jail. Charges of disorderly conduct, child abuse – intentionally cause harm, and resisting/obstructing a police officer have been forwarded to the Walworth County District Attorney's office.

On Monday, March 30th at approximately 9:30am officers responded to a residence in the 1400 block of Eastwood Road for a disorderly subject complaint. At the conclusion of the investigation charges of disorderly conduct were referred to the Walworth County District Attorney's office for a 20-year-old female and a 41-year-old female involved in the disturbance.

During the month of March 2020, the Bloomfield Police Department responded to 1011 calls for service compared to 743 calls for service during the month of March 2019. During the month of March 2020, the police department affected 95 arrests for various violations of Bloomfield Municipal Ordinances and Wisconsin State Statutes compared 112 arrests during the month of March 2019.
