

Some archaeologists have ranked ancient Petra as the eighth wonder of the ancient world – a truly justifiable claim. No picture can do justice to the jaw dropping facades and extensive city ruins. In Wadi rum, explore the canyons and water holes to discover 4000-year-old rock drawings and the many other spectacular treasures this vast wilderness holds in store.

DAY 1: JANUARY 12, 2023

Head to the Petra

Depart at 7am for Petra. Some archaeologists have ranked ancient Petra as the eighth wonder of the ancient world – a truly justifiable claim. Much of Petra's appeal comes from its awesome, multicolored sandstone high mountains; it is a secluded site of steep rocky slopes, towering craggy mountain tops and high cliffs, into which most of the celebrated tombs, facades, theaters and stairways are carved.

With your expert guide, you'll start your exploration from the visitor center going through the Siq to The Treasury. You will see the architecture and engineering that the Nabatean people used as aqueducts for water. While looking at and experiencing the old historical beliefs of the Nabatean people manifested as carvings on the way to the Siq (treasury).

Lunch and dinner will be provided today.

Check into the Old Village later today and overnight.



DAY 2: JANUARY 13, 2023 Wadi Rum

After breakfast enjoy a morning being a Shepard and walk in the steps of a Sheep herder. Learn about this unique way of life that hasn't changed in centuries.

Then depart to Wadi Rum, a stupendous, timeless place, virtually untouched by humanity and its destructive forces. Here, it is the weather and winds that have carved the imposing, towering skyscrapers, so elegantly described by T.E. Lawrence as "vast, echoing and god-like". A maze of monolithic rock-scape rise from the desert floor to heights of 1,750 meters creating a natural challenge for serious mountaineers.

Enjoy a 4-hour Bedouin jeep tour where you will explore the canyons and water holes to discover 4000-year-old rock drawings and the many other spectacular desert treasures.

During your tour, you will hike sand dunes, see Nabataean graffiti, visit Siq Umm Tawagi ("Siq Lawrence") where you will see the carvings of Lawrence of Arabia and Prince Abullah carved in to the sandstone by a local artisit. Experience the traditional Bedouin tea in an open goat hair woven tent.

Lunch will be provided at Wadi Rum

This evening enjoy a **traditional Bedouin dinner**, **zarb** which is lamb and chicken cooked underground on low heat for a couple of hours.




DAY 3: JANUARY 14, 2023

Fly home

Say farewell to Jordan today. Check out of the hotel and transfer to the Amman airport for your flight back to the U.S.
