- 44 - There was some ice build-up at the lagoons, so Mr. Thompson stopped discharging for now.

- 46 - Ms. Johnson gave the Treasurer's Report, stating that the total amount of all funds at the end of  
47 January was \$813,606.09.

- 49 - Council decided to change the fee schedule so that the park permit fees are no longer refundable,  
50 unless the applicant is a Rockford Town resident. There will be an updated resolution for approval
