#### Heart of a Mother

The Egyptian Pharaoh had ordered that all Hebrew boys be killed. Jochebed, a Hebrew mother, gave birth to a beautiful baby boy.

When he was three-months-old, Jochebed laid him in a floating ark by the river's bank. The baby's sister stood afar and watched.

Opening the ark, Pharaoh's daughter said with compassion, "This is one of the Hebrews' children." The sister offered to find a nurse.

The baby's mother nursed her own son. When the child grew, the mother took him to Pharaoh's daughter and he became her son. She called his name, "Moses." (Exodus 2)

These two mothers helped Moses grow into a fine and faithful man. God called him to lead the Hebrew people out of Egyptian slavery.

During a long, winding drive through the Italian Alps, two-year-old Alexandra Chalupa slept buckled in her backseat car seat. Awakening, she cried to sit up front; her mother refused.

Suddenly, their car skidded in the rain, lurched across traffic lanes, barely missed a deep gorge, and slammed against a solid rock wall. Her parents were bruised and shaken, but Alexandra was firmly fastened and unhurt.

At home in California, Tanya Chalupa launched a campaign for legislation requiring automobile safety seats for children under four years or weighing less than 40 pounds.

In 1983 after a four year campaign, the Child Restraint Law went into effect in California. Child-passenger injuries declined by more than 400 from the previous year. 1

Sarah Ann Reeves Moody considers herself "a simple person ... with a soft spot for kids."

Sarah's nephew, Stevie, was born without sweat glands, a condition called HED. Any exertion could overheat his body and cause serious damage. Playing could kill him!

Moody called NASA. If they put a man on the moon, they should be able to help Stevie.

Turns out they could. Moon travelers used a "cool suit." A \$2,600 cool suit! A variety of sales slowly brought in the money. One day eight-year-old Stevie donned his "cool suit" and took off on his bicycle on wings of joy. A foundation was started to help other children.<sup>2</sup>

Drew Ann Long of Alabaster, Alabama was a mom of three with a problem of navigating the grocery store with three young children, one of whom was disabled. After a vain search for a cart for people with special needs, she realized that she would have to invent one

She designed "Caroline's Cart" named after her daughter. This cart, which has handles opening in the front, drew her into the worlds of engineering, manufacturing, finance, patent law and the corporate boardroom.

Today, many stores offer "Caroline's Cart" because a mother would not give up. 3

Thus says the LORD, "As one whom his mother comforts, So I will comfort you ..." (Isaiah 66:13)



## The Acmar Community Quilt



While much of our articles focus on what Acmar was doing in the coal mining days, there are good things happening in present time that reinforce our hopes for the future. From the very beginning of Acmar, the education of young people was important. As the company built schools for the miners' children and even kept them open during the Depression when many state schools closed down, an emphasis on education continued.

While the cost of higher education keeps rising, the congregation of the Acmar church wanted to help worthy young people in some way by establishing a scholarship program in 2006 with a an amount of \$500 per recipient. A team of members of the congregation were tasked with developing guidelines and requirements.

#### These included:

- \*recommendation of a recipient by someone in our church family approved by Scholarship Team
- \*an application form with personal information
- \* a one page essay stating future educational plans and how the scholarship will help toward meeting those goals
- \*a recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, or a faculty member (if recommendation is not feasible, grade transcripts may be accepted.)

Applications each year must be received by April 1. The Scholarship Team will review applications and select recipient(s). Each recipient is given an Award Letter. Upon their enrollment, a check with that student's ID number is sent directly to the school. Recipients will have one year to redeem their scholarship.

In 2014, the church received \$10,000 from the estate of Lorraine Smith that was designated for educational scholarships. Lorraine always had a special place in her heart for young people, and her gift has helped many students.

As of spring, 2021, 34 scholarships have been awarded. These students have gone on to pursue a wide variety of careers that are important to society ranging from teachers, medical professions, business, finance, engineering, ministry, and even a pilot!
