## **LAKE AREA/BEACH FRONT**

**A friendly reminder that no individual owns the land and lake property. All First Nation lands are owned by all members and therefore no individual can deny access to any member at the lake area/beach front.**

**Also be advised that the following areas are restricted for public areas. Camping trailers and/or construction of any building are not to be located at the following sites:**

- 1. TFN Powwow grounds, including beach area**
- 2. Spring Creek**
- 3. Flat Rock**

**Please Note: These three areas will be official public beaches and will no longer allow motor vehicles to drive the lake front with the exception for the purpose of parking or boat launching.**

**TFN Chief and Council would like to remind all, that any individual(s) seeking a lot on TFN lake area must receive approval from the TFN Chief and Council.**
