Subject: HYDROMORPHONE (DILAUDID)

CLASS: Narcotic analgesic
ACTION: CNS depressant, peripheral vasodilation, and decreases pain.
INDICATIONS: Severe pain, burns, isolated extremity fractures, and kidney stones
CONTRAINDICATIONS: Head injury, volume depletion, known hypersensitivity, pregnancy, and altered mental status.
PRECAUTIONS: Respiratory depression (Narcan should be available), hypotension, and hepatic or renal impairment
Note: Narcan does not reverse hypotension caused by narcotic administration.
SIDE EFFECTS: Dizziness, bradycardia, altered level of consciousness, potential hypotension, nausea, vomiting, and respiratory depression.
DOSAGE: $0.5 - 1.0$ mg every 30 minutes prn.
ROUTE: IV, IO, or IM.
PEDIATRIC DOSE:

0.015 mg/kg.
