Chair Elaine Suskin was pleased to announce the winners of this year's CSRTA Scholarship. He is Jonathan Midey, grandson of Lynn Vanderveen. He will attend Ohio State studying communications. His application was outstanding and the letter of recommendation very supportive.

Elaine Suskin made a motion to award \$500 to this year's winner. Joe Barbera seconded the motion. It was carried.

The deadline for the 2023 scholarship will be January 1, 2023.

# UPDATE FROM THE CSTA:

Joe Barbera, our representative to the CSTA, gave the following update:

- The school budget vote in NYS will be May 17. Please vote yes. CSTA has endorsed all School Board candidates. There are 3 three year terms and 1 one year term. the candidate who receives the least number of votes will serve the one year term. All are incumbents except Mud Murphy.
- The Teachers Association and the District approved a 4 year contract, July 2022-26.

There is a 4% salary increase each year. \$150 longevity award and step increases. For retiring teachers there is a \$70 award for unused sick days, \$100 if there are over 100 days. If people opt out of the Insurance program there is a monetary incentive. Prescription prices, at certain classes, have increased. There is a Mitigation Pool of money available for people to send in receipts to get reimbursed for out of pocket expenses. This needs to be sent in by June1.

• The CSTA End of the Year Party will be at the 916 Restaurant in Brewerton on June 10. All retired teaches are invited. There will be a basket Raffle to support the Disaster Relief Fund. This money is used to help anyone who is in need.
