

PLANT OPERATOR
LATERAL TRANSFER OPPORTUNITY
CITY OF BEDFORD HEIGHTS

The City of Bedford Heights Water Reclamation Department is now accepting applications for lateral transfer for the civil service position of Plant Operator in the wastewater treatment facility. Applicants must have a minimum of a Class I Wastewater Certification and have worked within the past two (2) years as a Plant Operator. Applicants must be willing to work 12-hour shifts. Pay periods are 84 hours: one 48-hour work week, and one 36-hour work week. Pay range for 2019 is \$22.99 to \$27.68 per hour.

Plant Operators are responsible for all daily functions of the treatment plant, processing grit, grease, sludge removal, dewatering sludge on a belt filter press, lab testing, tertiary treatment, light maintenance of equipment, landscaping, janitorial cleaning, and painting. The activated sludge treatment plant is a 3.6 MGD dry weather and a 7.5 MGD wet weather facility.

Each applicant must be a citizen of the United States or have declared intention to become a citizen, be able to read and write English, possess a high school diploma or equivalent and be 18 years of age on the date of hire.

Civil service applications for lateral transfer can be downloaded from the city's website, www.bedfordheights.gov, under Civil Service Examination and Application, from December 13, 2018, through January 31, 2019, and also at the Bedford Heights city hall reception desk, 5661 Perkins Road, Bedford Heights, OH 44146, weekdays from 8:30-5:00 during the above dates (excluding January 21). Completed applications along, with a \$25 application fee, must be mailed to the Civil Service Secretary between December 13, 2018, and January 31, 2019, at the above-mentioned address.
