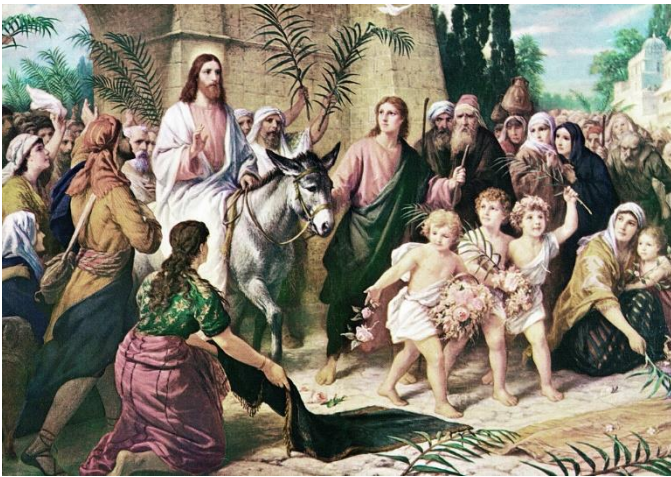

PALM SUNDAY



“When the great crowd heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, they took palm branches and went out to meet him, and cried out: ‘Hosanna! / Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord, [even] the king of Israel!’ (12:12-13) †

WHY ARE THE PEOPLE WAVING PALM BRANCHES?

It was a common custom in many lands in the ancient Near East to cover the path of someone thought worthy of the highest honor. The Hebrew Bible reports that Joshua was treated this way. The gospels of Mark, Matthew and John report that people gave Jesus this form of honor. In Matthew/Mark they are reported as laying their garments and cut branches on the street, whereas John more specifically mentions palm fronds.

PALM SUNDAY OF THE LORD'S PASSION

Every year on the Sunday before Easter – the sixth Sunday of Lent – the church celebrates “Palm Sunday.” Most general calendars list the day as “Palm Sunday,” but if you look closely at a liturgical calendar you will see that it is actually called “Palm Sunday of the Lord’s Passion.” The name is appropriate as it celebrates Jesus’ triumphal entry into Jerusalem but also commemorates the beginning of Holy Week and Jesus’ final journey to the cross.
