Goat Show Registration and Weigh-In will be from 1 PM - 1:30 PM on Friday of the fair. Registration will be located at the scale house on the south side of the fairgrounds. Goat Show will begin immediately following the lamb show. The goat show starts at 3pm, or immediately after the sheep show.

All standard 4-H and Marcus Fair Livestock rules apply. All goats will be vet checked upon arrival. Any goat showing signs of contagious disease will be unable to be shown. Disqualified goats must be removed from the fairgrounds immediately.

There is no sale associated with this show. The Goat show is come and go with no penning space on the fairgrounds. There is a wash rack available to use. Please plan accordingly. There is no limit to the number of breeding goats that may be exhibited but Exhibitors may only show 3 market goats. Either does or wethers may be shown in the market classes, there is no weight limit. All breeding does must be identified with a scrapie ID tag.

ALL Classes will be divided by weight. There will be no declared weights. If you show your goat in the breeding class you can NOT show the same goat in a market class.

Ribbons will be awarded and Plaques will be awarded to the Champion and Reserve Champion goats and showmen/women.
