

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR THOSE ENTERING PRE-K – 12<sup>TH</sup> GRADES, FALL 2015

<b>MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS</b>	<b>PRE-KINDERGARTEN</b>
DTP/Dtap/or Tdap, Td	Three doses by 1 year. One additional booster by 2 years.
Polio	Two doses by 1 year. One additional booster by 2 years.
MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)	One dose on or after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday but prior to 24 months.
Haemophilus influenzae type B	Refer to schedule. Those (24-59 months) without series must have one dose after 15 months.
Invasive Pneumococcal Disease	Refer to PCV schedule. Those (24-59 months) without series must have one dose.
Hepatitis B	Three doses for all children 2 years of age and older. Third dose must have been administered on or after 6 months.
Varicella (chicken pox)	One dose on or after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday or proof of disease.
Physical exam	By physician within one year of school entrance.

<b>MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS</b>	<b>KINDERGARTEN</b>
DTP/Dtap/or Tdap, Td	Four or more doses of DTP/DtaP with the last dose qualifying as a booster and received on or after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday.
Polio (OPV, IPV)	Three or more doses (IPV or OPV) with the last qualifying as a booster and received on or after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday.
MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)	Two doses with the first dose received after the 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday and the second no less than 4 weeks later.
Varicella (chicken pox)	Two doses (or proof of disease) with the first dose received on or after the 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday and the second no less than 4 weeks later.
Vision exam	By optometrist/ophthalmologist within one year of school entrance.
Dental exam	By dentist within 18 months of May 15, 2016.
Physical exam	By physician within 12 months of school entrance and includes a lead screening for those under 6 years.

Dental exam	By dentist within 18 months of May 15, 2016

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR THOSE ENTERING PRE-K – 12<sup>TH</sup> GRADES, FALL 2015

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS	SIXTH GRADE
Dental exam	By dentist within 18 months of May 15, 2016.
Physical exam	By physician within one year of school entrance.
Tdap	<b>One dose</b>
Varicella (chicken pox)	<b>Two doses</b> (or proof of disease) with the first dose received on or after the 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday and the second no less than 4 weeks later.
Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine	<b>One dose</b> of MCV4 at school entry on or after the 11 <sup>th</sup> birthday.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS	1 <sup>ST</sup> THROUGH 12 <sup>TH</sup> GRADES (excluding 6 <sup>th</sup> and 9 <sup>th</sup> )
Varicella (chicken pox)	One dose on or after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS	6 <sup>TH</sup> THROUGH 12 <sup>TH</sup> GRADES
Hepatitis B	Three doses at recommended intervals.
Tdap	One dose

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS	NINTH GRADE
Varicella (chicken pox)	<b>Two doses</b> (or proof of disease) with 1 <sup>st</sup> dose received on or after the 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday and the second no less than 4 weeks later.
Physical exam	By physician within one year of school entrance.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS	TWELVETH GRADE
Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine	<b>Two doses</b> of MCV4 at school entry; 2 <sup>nd</sup> dose must be administered on or after the 16 <sup>th</sup> birthday. If the first dose is received after the 16 <sup>th</sup> birthday, only 1 dose is required.

- For those participating in a sports' activity during the 2015-2016 school year, a current physical must be on file prior to the beginning of any practice. The physical must have been received within 395 days of the beginning of the sport. If a sports' physical exceeds 395 days during the course of the sport, the athlete is required to obtain another physical in order to continue playing.
- As a school who receives federal funds, St. Mary School is legally required by the Illinois School Code to meet any and all of the minimum requirements for school entrance.

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
