# **Library Update**

Fall is in the air this week! We are planning for the last part of 2021. I hope find you can something here at that the library

Sheree Rose Kelley will be back with us at 6:00 pm on Thursday, September 30<sup>th</sup> for a "Taste and Tell" at the Giles Heritage Theater at First National Bank. She will share how to prepare some of her recipes from her latest cookbook, Servin' Up Summer. She will have her cookbooks for sale at this event. This event was postponed from August 24<sup>th</sup>. We are looking forward to it.

Our 80th Anniversary Celebration for the public is on Saturday, October 16th. We are very appreciative of this library and very proud to celebrate its 80th year history with all of you. This celebration includes a book character dress-up parade. Come and join us in the parade! We are also having a chalk art competition. If you want to participate in the chalk art competition, let us know so we can reserve a spot for you. We are having face painting, give-away items for adults and kids, story-telling, old picture displays, a photo booth, and food and drinks. Mark your calendar and come to help us celebrate!

This December the **James Webb Space Telescope (JWST)** will be launched. It will be the largest, most powerful and complex space telescope ever built and launched into space. The Webb Space Telescope will complement and extend the discoveries of the Hubble Space Telescope. We are one of the lucky institutions to be selected to host a Launch **Event!** Our launch event is scheduled for Saturday, November 6<sup>th</sup> from 3:00 – 7:00pm on the Campus Green of UT Southern. We will have Dr. Liz Badolato, Assistant Professor from UT Southern on hand for this event. She teaches physics and astronomy and also works at the Space and Rocket Center. We are also hoping to have a NASA Subject Matter Expert on hand that evening. Most of the activities will be outdoors, weather permitting or in the

Gault Center. We are very excited to be selected to host this event!

We have also received a grant called NASA @ My Library that goes along with the launch event of the JWST. So that means we will be having a few more events during the next year to tell you about as the telescope is launched, unfolds to its full extent, and starts to examine the formation of galaxies, stars and planets to the evolution of our solar system.

Saturday, December 4<sup>th</sup> we will be decorating Keepsake Christmas Plates again. This event will be held at the 4-H building behind the library. We will have five sessions beginning at 10:00 AM. Call the library to sign your children up to decorate a Christmas Keepsake Plate!

Tuesday, December 7<sup>th</sup> is **Adult Christmas Craft Night**. If you would is **Adult** like to come and make an elegant ornament or create your own Christmas Plate, come and join us for the evening from 5:00 -7:00pm for adult crafting for Christmas!

All of our regular programs are still happening like Friday Morning Story Time, Lego Club, Fandomonium Teen Afternoons, Teen Creative Club, and **Dungeons & Dragons Club.**




