

## Log Cabin Hexi Potholders

For our February Workshop, we will be making Log Cabin Hexi Potholders with partial seams. This is a perfect way to use up scrap fabric & batting. This is also a great item to practice quilting on and will be a great addition to your kitchen. Do not be afraid of the partial seams this was an easy and quick project.

Finished size Approximately 9" X 10"

Materials and Supplies needed:

- 6 strips of fabric – 2" x 4"
- 6 strips of fabric – 2" x 6"
- 1 Hexagon center (hexi template provided in class, bring a 5x5 square of fabric to cut from)
- 9" X 10" piece of batting (I just used 2 pieces of Insulbrite & no batting)
- 9" X 10" insulbrite
- 6" long ribbon (optional)
- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing supplies
- Ruler & Cutting Mat
