*Texas A&M QB Marcel Reed led the No. 16 Aggies to a dramatic 41-40 upset win over No. 8 Notre Dame last Saturday. Reed threw for 360 yards including a TD pass on 4th & 11 with just 13 seconds left. The loss dropped ND to 0-2.*

### Misleading Finals

**Arizona (+1.5) upset Kansas State 23-17.** It was much worse than the final as Arizona had a 412-193 yard edge. Arizona RB Mahdi ran for 189 yards.

**Texas Tech (-24) beat Oregon State 45-14.** Oregon State got a couple of TD drives in the fourth quarter down 45-0.

**USC (-20.5) beat Purdue 33-17.** The Trojans were +3 in turnovers and scored a long defensive TD by a 350-pound NT. All three of Purdue's turnovers came inside the USC red zone.

**Bowling Green (+6) upset Liberty 23-13.** However, Liberty had a 332-304 yard edge. Liberty was -4 in turnovers.

**Southern Miss (+3.5) upset Appalachian State 38-22.** However, Appalachian State had a 470-389 yard edge. Appalachian State's QB threw three interceptions at the goal line. One of them got returned 99-yards for a TD!

**Ole Miss (-3.5) beat Arkansas 41-35.** However, Arkansas had a 526-475 yard edge. The Razorbacks missed two field goals and fumbled late in the game while driving for a possible winning score.

**LSU (-4.5) beat Florida 20-10.** However, Florida had a 366-316 yard edge. Gators' QB DJ Lagway threw five interceptions including one that was returned for a touchdown.

**Middle Tennessee (+9.5) upset Nevada 14-13.** However, Nevada led 13-0 in the fourth quarter. The Wolf Pack missed two field goals in the game and Middle Tennessee scored the game-winning TD with just :23 left.

**UAB (-12) beat Akron 31-28.** The Zips did have a 441-422 yard edge and UAB got a 96-yard kickoff return TD on the opening play.

### Bad Beats

**Oregon (-24.5) beat Northwestern 34-14.** Oregon led 34-0 in the middle of the fourth quarter. Northwestern got 166 yards and 2 TD's on their final two drives. That included a 79-yard TD run with 1:48 left that gave them the back-door cover.

**Penn State (-47.5) beat Villanova 52-6.** The total on the game was 56.5. Entering the fourth quarter, Penn State led 31-0. The Nittany Lions tacked on three more TD's including a 49-yard "Pick 6". On the ensuing possession, Villanova went 16 plays and 75 yards. The Wildcats would score on the final play of the game. It was a highlight throw across the field and the receiver made a leaping one-handed catch. If you haven't seen it yet, we recommend you do. It might be the play of the year and it probably is the bad beat of the year so far because it impacted both side and total.

## Games in Rotation Order

### Thursday, September 18th

**Rice 24 CHARLOTTE 21.** Both teams come in off wins over FCS opponents and both have first-year head coaches. Turnovers have hurt Charlotte so far at -6. Rice does have the much better defense (No. 43 vs No. 127) but traveling on a short week. We're passing.

### Friday, September 19th

**OKLAHOMA STATE 35 Tulsa 21.** Oklahoma State is coming off a bye while Tulsa is traveling (not far) on a short week. The Cowboys were annihilated the last time we saw them losing 69-3 at Oregon. Coming off a 3-9 season, you have to wonder if we're nearing the end of the Gundy era. Our ratings do say there is some value on them here.

**Iowa 23 RUTGERS 22.** A really important game to kick off the Big Ten schedule for both schools. Iowa has been better in yards per play margin (+1.5 vs -0.2). The Hawkeyes have a big edge on defense allowing just 3.5 ypp (No. 4) while Rutgers is allowing 6.6 (No. 123). Our ratings say Iowa is the play but we don't trust their offense.

### Saturday, September 20th

**ARMY 26 North Texas 25.** North Texas had one of the more impressive performances of the season so far as they crushed Washington State 59-10 as 7-point favorites last week. That's a 42-point cover. Now they travel east and face an Army team off a bye. Army's loss to Tarleton looks better considering Tarleton might be a Top 2-3 FCS team this year and Army upset Kansas State in their last game. The Black Knights had the ball for 27 of the 30 minutes in the second half. Lot of money on UNDER and North Texas so far. We lean Army.

**TCU 34 Smu 29.** Iron Skillet. TCU leads all-time 53-43-7 but SMU won 66-42 last year. Both teams are banged up as TCU might be without their starting RB. However, SMU has several injuries and that might be a good reason they struggled vs Missouri State last week. That includes QB Jennings who doesn't look 100%. We're passing.

**UL-Lafayette 25 EASTERN MICHIGAN 22.** Louisiana's QB's combined for 2 of 14 for 4 yards last week in the loss to Missouri. You read that right...ULL completed 2 passes for 4 yards! However, it's tough trusting a EMU defense that ranks 2nd to last in ypp, ypg and ppg. We've downgraded ULL 8 points already since the start of the season but yet our ratings like them here. We prefer UNDER.

**GEORGIA TECH 38 Temple 15.** Definitely a flat spot here for Georgia Tech off the big win over Clemson. You should also be paying attention to QB King's status as he takes a lot of hits and the Yellow Jackets have a capable backup. The market loves this Temple team this year but the Owls were destroyed by Oklahoma last week. Early money on Temple but we're not involved.

**CENTRAL FLORIDA 28 North Carolina 23.** Really good matchup here to get a better idea of what these teams will look like this year under first-year coaches. The first game was a disaster for Belichick but the Tar Heels have looked competent on defense the last two weeks (albeit vs Charlotte and Richmond). UCF is off a bye. They almost lost to Jacksonville St as a 20-point favorite and then hammered an FCS opponent. A lot of money on UNDER and UCF so far. We lean NC.

**MIAMI, OH 26 UNLV 25.** UNLV is coming off a bye but we don't like them playing an early 9am PT start. The Rebels are 3-0 but they almost lost as a 30-point favorite to Idaho St, beat a 0-3 first-year coach led Sam Houston team and then upset a 0-3 UCLA team that lost by 25 to New Mexico the next week. Miami, OH is 0-2 and desperate. They've lost to Wisconsin and Rutgers. It's the biggest strength of schedule disparity this week. Redhawks outright.

**Byu 29 EAST CAROLINA 22.** We were hoping we'd get +10 on East Carolina here. Last week's 38-0 win over Coastal Carolina as a 7-point favorite (VIP clients got ECU) ruined those chances. We think BYU is a little overrated having played a bad FCS team and Stanford. First road start for a true freshman QB but the market is all over this.

**MIAMI, FL 28 Florida 21.** Miami embarrassed Florida last year 41-17 in the opener. The Hurricanes have looked as good as anyone so far and last week destroyed USF 49-12 the week after USF upset Florida 18-16. Florida took a ton of money last week. The Gators fell 20-10 at LSU as 4.5-point underdogs (opened as high as 9.5). You can make a strong case that Florida was clearly the right side if not for FIVE interceptions by QB DJ Lagway. Is this Billy Napier's last stand or does Miami start making a case to be ranked No. 1? We didn't bet the game but agree with the UNDER money.

**LOUISVILLE 38 Bowling Green 13.** BG has looked pretty good so far under new coach Eddie George. The Falcons pulled the upset last week 23-13 as 6-point home underdogs but benefited from a +4 TO margin. Louisville is coming off a bye. The Cardinals are 2-0 SU but 0-2 ATS. We don't expect to be involved.

## HOME TEAM IN CAPS

**CLEMSON 37 Syracuse 20.** If you bet Clemson's win total UNDER 10.5 at the end of the summer, congrats. The Tigers have already lost two games outright as a short favorite. We're not sure how they will respond here. Syracuse is putting up big numbers in the passing game as QB Steve Angeli leads the nation in passing yards so far but a lot of that came vs Connecticut when trailing and vs Colgate last week. It's another game we didn't bet.

**INDIANA 28 Illinois 24.** Incredible that this is the NBC Saturday night game featuring a pair of Top 20 teams. Kudos to Illinois for taking care of business last week vs Western Michigan. The Illini are ranked No. 9 but yet find themselves a 5.5-point underdog to No. 19 Indiana. We've said all summer the Illini are way overrated compared to their AP ranking. We bet Indiana -2.5 on the Sunday openers and so far the market has agreed. However, we can't recommend the Hoosiers at current. Neither team has played a tough schedule so far.

**DUKE 31 NC State 27.** We like a desperate 1-2 Duke team vs a 3-0 "fat and happy" NC State team here. The Blue Devils are the much better team in the stats with a +1.6 yards per play margin (NC State +0.1) despite playing similar strength of schedules. A -6 turnover margin has been the Blue Devils' undoing. If they play clean, they are the right side and we gave them out (-2.5) to clients this week.

**FLORIDA STATE 52 Kent State 7.** FSU comes in off a bye after destroying East Texas A&M. Their season really gets going next week at Virginia on Friday night. Kent State almost pulled off the shocker of the year as they led Buffalo 28-24 as 24-point underdogs last week late in the fourth quarter but lost. The Golden Flashes did lose by 48 to Texas Tech and we expect something similar here. We like OVER.

**Toledo 31 WESTERN MICHIGAN 20.** Toledo is riding high at 3-0 ATS and off a pair of blowout home wins. They're facing a Western Michigan team that is 0-3 and desperate. This is exactly the type of game Toledo head coach Jason Candle struggles with. We like WMU. **BUFFALO 25 Troy 19.** On Sunday Draft Kings opened Buffalo -1.5 at 12:30pm ET. An hour later Circa opened Buffalo -12.5! We thought the truth was somewhere in the middle and so far the market agrees. The mis-pricing revolves around Troy losing QB Goose Crowder to injury last week. The backups were abysmal as Troy only managed 112 total yards. Buffalo did almost lose to Kent State last week.

**WISCONSIN 28 Maryland 19.** Wisconsin took some big-time steam last Saturday vs Alabama as the line went from +21 to +18 before kick-off. Usually that signifies an injury but there wasn't one. The Badgers money was not correct as Alabama easily handled them. Flash forward to this week and the Badgers are taking a ton of money again. There's a chance Billy Edwards returns here vs his old team. Maryland hasn't played anyone yet but we can't lay the doubles with this UW offense.

**SOUTH ALABAMA 30 Coastal Carolina 17.** Coastal Carolina's offense ranks dead last averaging just 6.7 points per game. Last week they took a lot of gameday steam going from +10 to +7. That steam was big time wrong as they got crushed 38-0 to East Carolina. South Alabama has easily covered as a big dog the last two weeks vs Tulane and Auburn. Tough for us to lay this number though considering last week's ECU price vs Coastal. Lean UNDER.

**TENNESSEE 53 Uab 15.** Despite the heart-breaking loss, Tennessee really showed us something last week vs Georgia. The Vols should have won the game. Will they be flat here? We don't think it will matter vs a UAB defense allowing 473 ypp (No. 131) despite playing a weak schedule. We bet OVER and the market has hammered it this week.

**Utsa 31 COLORADO STATE 27.** This is a big game for both schools and especially if you bet the win totals on either. Colorado State is off a bye after almost losing as a 35-point favorite. Last week UTSA easily dispatched their FCS opponent. It will be interesting to see if Colorado State can get their offense going. We didn't bet it.

**COLORADO 29 Wyoming 15.** Colorado's season feels like it is going sideways already. While the Buffs weren't favored vs either Georgia Tech or Houston, they were handled at the line of scrimmage in both and can't figure out the QB position. Wyoming is off a 31-6 loss to Utah which was worse than the final. We bet the Buffs hoping to get the best number. They take late week steam regularly.

**UTAH 31 Texas Tech 27.** We know Auburn/Oklahoma, Michigan/Nebraska and Florida/Miami will get more eyeballs but this is the game of the week for us in CFB. The winner becomes the Big 12 favorite. Both are 3-0 straight up. Both are 3-0 ATS. Both have not played anyone with a pulse. We trust Whittingham more than McGuire and Salt Lake can be a very tough place to play (albeit it's a 10am local start). We bet Utah -2.5 at Fan Duel on Tuesday night. We also bet First Half UNDER 29.5 at Fan Duel on Wednesday morning.



**OREGON 47 Oregon State 12.** Nothing says Oregon/Oregon State "Civil War" more than airing on the Big Ten Network. Oregon led Northwestern 34-0 last week and called off the dogs as the Wildcats scored a couple of late TD's. With Penn State on deck, will we something similar here? Oregon State is 0-3 SU and 0-3 ATS. We expected improvement this year but it is clear that head coach Trent Bray is in over his head and will need to be replaced.

**OKLAHOMA 26 Auburn 21.** Game of the week in the SEC. Both teams 3-0. Both have a nice win already (OU over Michigan, Auburn at Baylor) and both looking to start the conference schedule off right. We think OU's defense is the best unit of the bunch and it will be interesting to see how Venables defends his former QB Arnold. We haven't bet the game yet but we are looking for an Auburn "+7".

**OLE MISS 37 Tulane 26.** Ole Miss backup QB Chambliss threw for 353 yards last week as Ole Miss held on to beat Arkansas 41-35. Starting QB Simmons is questionable here but it looks like the Rebels offense will be fine either way. On the other side, Tulane already has Power 4 wins over Northwestern and Duke. A third would put them in the driver's seat to get the Group of 5 playoff bid. We bet Tulane but prefer the OVER at current.

**KANSAS 31 West Virginia 21.** This is a good spot for Kansas coming off a bye catching West Virginia off an OT win over their arch rival Pittsburgh. However, that's why the line is 2 TD's. We can't get that high in our ratings. The two teams have played similar strength of schedules and Kansas is only slightly better in ypp margin (+1.9 vs +1.6). West Virginia is the better running team. We like WVU.

**BAYLOR 31 Arizona State 30.** While it maybe over-shadowed by the Texas Tech/Utah game, this game is nearly as important in the Big 12 race. Both teams suffered tough non-conference losses to SEC teams. Arizona State is the better running team and is better in the stats (+1.4 ypp margin vs +0.6). We lean with them here

**USC 37 Michigan State 20.** USC is getting steamed big time this week in this matchup. We haven't been impressed with Michigan State who is 3-0 straight up but 0-3 ATS. The Spartans are banged up at multiple positions. This game kicks off at 11pm ET. We saw last week Boston College and Minnesota really struggle in the West Coast late night starts. Trojans roll but the value has dried up in the market.

**CONNECTICUT 37 Ball State 17.** Connecticut comes in off a tough upset loss in OT to Delaware last week. That's now back-to-back OT losses for the Huskies. They're catching a Ball State team of their first win of the season over FCS New Hampshire. We know Ball State is a bottom 5 team in the FBS but this line feels too pricey for a UConn team still learning how to win let alone covering big spreads.

**Arkansas 34 MEMPHIS 27.** We came away impressed with Arkansas last week especially on offense. They easily could have beat Ole Miss if not for a couple of missed FG's and a late fumble. Memphis is 3-0 straight up and 3-0 ATS. However, they've played a weak schedule and benefited from Troy losing their starting QB early last week. This is a bad spot for Arkansas with Notre Dame on deck but we're a part of the early week steam on them (opened under 5).

**Michigan 24 NEBRASKA 23.** If you consider the stakes and the competitive point spread, this is the biggest Nebraska home game in at least a decade. The Huskers come in at 3-0. However, they haven't played a tough schedule and Cincinnati did push them around in the second half of the opener. Michigan used QB Bryce Underwood's legs last week and beat Central Michigan by 60. Interim Biff Poggi will be the coach again here with Sherrone Moore's suspension. We don't see much value here unless a "+3" shows in the market.

**NOTRE DAME 40 Purdue 16.** Notre Dame comes in at 0-2 suffering last minute losses to Miami and Texas A&M. The Irish would have to win out to have a shot at the playoffs now. They were in a similar spot last year and made it to the National Title game. However, they also had Al Golden as a DC. ND could be without a couple starters in the secondary. Purdue did move the football vs USC but were done in by three red zone interceptions! We bet Purdue and the OVER

**VIRGINIA 33 Stanford 17.** Stanford got a big upset win over Boston College last week. The Cardinal were 14-point underdogs and finally found some offense. This is a tough spot though traveling across the country to a Virginia team that is averaging 556 ypg (No. 8). The Cavs do have FSU on deck at home on Friday. We need a "+17" to show to be interested in the Cardinal.

**MISSOURI 30 South Carolina 20.** This is a one-factor handicap revolving around South Carolina QB LaNorris Sellers who got concussed last week. If he plays, this line will close near 7. If he doesn't, the line will close near 14. He's that valuable. We'll split the difference for now. Missouri has been better than expected.

**MISSISSIPPI STATE 35 Northern Illinois 15.** We think this could be a "sleepy" spot for Mississippi State. They're 3-0 straight up and ATS and have a big home game vs Tennessee on deck. Northern Illinois is coming off a bye. We bet NIU.

**Fresno State 26 HAWAII 23.** Main factor here is that QB Micah Alejado who has missed the last 2.5 games will get the start here for Hawaii. It's a huge game for them in terms of getting to a bowl. Both teams are 3-1 and both are coming off wins over FCS foes. The market likes Hawaii so far but we're leaning with Fresno who is better in the stats, has played the tougher schedule and is the better running team.

**James Madison 29 LIBERTY 20.** Liberty comes in off back-to-back upset losses as a 6-point road favorite. The Flames had the yardage edge in both games but were a combined -6 in turnovers. James Madison is off a bye and played Louisville closer than the final a couple weeks ago. Their defense is allowing just 206 ypg (No. 7). A big difference in opinion on this one as one sportsbook opened JMU -6.5 but it got as high as -12.5 before there was buy back on Liberty. Both teams are combined 5-0 to the UNDER this year.

**Arkansas State 30 KENNESAW STATE 24.** It's the resistible force vs the movable object. Kennesaw has the No. 115 offense that takes on Arkansas State's No. 132 defense. Kennesaw is the better team in the ypp stats but Arkansas State has played the tougher schedule. A lot of money has come in on Kennesaw here but we haven't bet side or total.

**FIU 30 Delaware 24.** A lot of money came in on Delaware late last week and that proved to be correct as they upset Connecticut 44-41 in OT as 8.5-point underdogs. FIU is also coming off a big home win as they beat arch rival FAU in the Shula Bowl for the first time since 2016. We bet FIU earlier in the week but the market is all over this.

**WESTERN KENTUCKY 33 Nevada 21.** Quite frankly, Nevada suffered an unacceptable loss last week. The Wolf Pack led Middle Tennessee 13-0 in the fourth quarter but lost in the final seconds as 9.5-point favorites. Now they're taking on a WKU team that had a bye week to vent about their blowout loss to Toledo. Early money is on WKU here and we agree.

**Boise State 31 AIR FORCE 21.** We are a part of the Boise steam. The Broncos had a bye week to prep for the option. The early week markets feel like they have thrown Boise in the trash since the USF loss but we felt that final was misleading. Air Force is coming off an upset loss to Utah State. The Falcons defense looks like it has taken a step back.

**Marshall 24 MIDDLE TENNESSEE 22.** We bet against Marshall last week and they surprised us with an easy win over Eastern Kentucky. Speaking of surprises, Middle trailed Nevada 13-0 in the fourth quarter but pulled out a 14-13 upset win as 9.5-point underdogs. Our ratings lean Marshall here but we don't trust them yet.

**LOUISIANA TECH 27 Southern Miss 23.** We like Louisiana Tech here. The Bulldogs have the better yards per play margin (+0.5 vs +0.0) and have played a slightly tougher schedule. Southern Miss is 2-1 but is off some misleading finals. The Golden Eagles are -68 ypg this season and benefited from three App State turnovers at the goal line last week. We think the LT defense is the best unit.

**Washington 36 WASHINGTON STATE 17.** Good to see the Apple Cup still being played. Washington State upset Washington last year but that won't be the case here. Wazzu with a first-year coach is struggling and lost by 49 to North Texas last week. Washington is off a bye but does have Ohio State at home on deck. Pass at current.

**VANDERBILT 40 Georgia State 13.** Vanderbilt comes in off back-to-back upset wins on the road. You'd think classic letdown spot here. However, Georgia State upset Vanderbilt last year and that should have Vandy more focused than usual. Don't look now but it's looking more and more like Vandy will be 5-0 heading to Alabama in October.

**TEXAS 44 Sam Houston State 6.** Arch Manning was 11 of 25 for 114 yards last week. Did he play against Ohio State again? Nope, this stat line came against UTEP. The All-22 breakdown is even worse. They are playing another weak opponent here. Our ratings lean Texas but tough laying this kind of number with an overrated QB.

**UTEP 25 UL-Monroe 23.** The market really likes UTEP here. The Miners have had back-to-back impressive performances including only losing 27-10 at Texas last week. ULM comes in off a bye. The Warhawks lost 73-0 to Alabama prior. They are a better running team and might be a better overall team. Our ratings love them here.

**California 30 SAN DIEGO STATE 19.** Cal is 3-0 straight up and feeling good about themselves after an upset win over Minnesota. This is a dangerous spot for them playing a San Diego State team off a bye. However, the Aztecs 23-point loss to Washington State looks horrific now that Wazzu lost by 49 to North Texas. We didn't bet the game.

## **Games in Rotation Order**

### **Thursday, September 18th**

**BUFFALO 30 Miami 19.** Miami comes in 0-2. The Dolphins were crushed in the season opener. How do they respond? How about getting outscored 12-0 to start the game at home to New England last week. The Dolphins rallied to take the lead in the fourth quarter but NE returned a kickoff for a TD. You thought flat spot for Buffalo last week...NOPE. The Bills crushed the Jets. The stats (BUF +0.2 in ypp margin, MIA +0.0) say this shouldn't be a 12-point spread. However, there's always a chance for a no-show with the Dolphins under their soon-to-be lame duck coach.

### **Sunday, September 21st**

**Indianapolis 24 TENNESSEE 20.** 2-0 team vs an 0-2 team. Have to think there is some value on the 0-2 team right? We're not so sure. Indianapolis did get a fortunate win over Denver last week thanks to a penalty on a missed FG on the final play. The Colts are No. 4 in the NFL in yards per play margin. The Titans rank dead last in that category at -2.6. Tennessee did give a solid effort last week in the first half as they led the Rams 13-10. However, they were outplayed in the second. We don't have any interest here.

**Atlanta 24 CAROLINA 20** Atlanta comes in off an impressive road upset of Minnesota where they limited the Vikings to 198 yards and forced four turnovers. Atlanta's rookie draft class looks like the real deal with several contributors already. Carolina 0-2 and the Panthers rank No. 30 in ypp margin. They trailed Arizona 27-3 last week but did almost rally all the way back. Early week money is on Atlanta but we think the price is a bit steep.

**WASHINGTON 23 Las Vegas 20.** The big factor here is will Jayden Daniels play. Right now he is listed as day-to-day (aren't we all) with a knee sprain. Right now, the line indicates we are more likely to see Marcus Mariota. Both teams had disappointing Week 2's as the Commanders fell at the Packers and the Raiders lost at home to the Chargers. Washington does have the rest edge here having played Thursday while Las Vegas played Monday night.

**Green Bay 23 CLEVELAND 17.** Green Bay comes in at 2-0 straight up and ATS. They beat a pair of NFC playoff teams from last year and did so with the largest yards per play margin so far in the NFL at +2.4. The Clowns...we mean Browns come in at 0-2 and were embarrassed by Baltimore 41-17 last week. This seems easy right? Well Cleveland is No. 7 in ypp margin at +0.7 as turnovers and special teams errors have cost them the last two weeks. We're putting the clothespin on the nose and taking the stinky dog.

**MINNESOTA 22 Cincinnati 19.** JJ McCarthy...yikes! How about 11 of 21 with 2 interceptions in your first home start. To make things worse...McCarthy has an ankle sprain and we could get Carson Wentz here. Speaking of backups getting a start, Jake Browning will start for the injured Joe Burrow. Browning rallied the Bengals last week in the fourth quarter over the Jaguars but did throw three interceptions. Week 3 and we're already talking backup QB's in like half the games. Ugh!

**PHILADELPHIA 23 L.A. Rams 21.** Of rematch of last year's divisional game which Philadelphia won in the snow. Both teams enter 2-0. However, the Rams have been much more dominant with a +2.0 yards per play margin while the Eagles are -1.0. It should be noted the Eagles have played the tougher schedule. A couple of groups we respect have played the Rams so far this week and we think they are live at pulling the outright upset.

**NEW ENGLAND 23 Pittsburgh 22.** Both come in at 1-1 and neither team has looked that great. Pittsburgh is -1.5 in yards per play margin. New England is -1.2 in yards per play margin. The Patriots got a kick return TD that swung back momentum in their win over the Dolphins. Meanwhile, the Steelers were outscored 24-3 in the second half at home by the Seahawks. Pittsburgh is getting some sharp play in the early week markets. We don't agree and would certainly be interested in New England on a teaser.

**TAMPA BAY 24 N.Y. Jets 20.** We've had a couple of groups that typically go later in the week (meaning they bet big) go on the Jets here. There is speculation that Tampa Bay QB Mayfield is more injured than this line is indicating. Tampa is a very fortunate 2-0 team getting a dramatic win over the Texans on MNF (much to our dismay). Tampa is -0.5 in ypp margin. The 0-2 Jets are -0.4 in ypp margin. We like the Jets here.

## **HOME TEAM IN CAPS**

**JACKSONVILLE 23 Houston 22.** Houston comes in at 0-2. They thought they had a win on MNF but couldn't get a stop on 4th & long and then gave up a TD in the final seconds to Tampa Bay. Jacksonville also had a tough loss last week to Cincinnati. The Jags have been impressive in the box score with a +1.0 ypp margin (No. 5). We're not sure Houston gets the win here but we do like them in a teaser through the key numbers of 3 and 7.

**L.A. CHARGERS 24 Denver 22.** The Chargers are 2-0 with both wins coming against division rivals and both coming away from home. They've been impressive in the box score with a +1.5 yards per play margin (No. 3) and a +11% success rate (No. 1). Denver would also enter this game at 2-0 if not for an ill-timed penalty on a missed FG last week. Their opponent the Colts made the FG (15 yards closer) on the re-try. Third game in a row, we'd be interested in the underdog on a teaser.

**SEATTLE 23 New Orleans 17.** New Orleans is 0-2 but the Saints have been a little better than expected. They are only -0.2 in yards per play margin (No. 18) and played a pair of teams with playoff aspirations. QB Rattler threw 3 TD passes last week but it wasn't enough vs the 49ers. The Seahawks got a big win over the Steelers. Seattle had a 395-267 yard edge. However, we're not sure we can lay this kind of number with them. We lean New Orleans.

**Dallas 25 CHICAGO 24.** This game used to mean something in the NFC back in the day. Now it's just a couple of franchises that haven't won a Super Bowl in 3 and 4 decades. Dallas got the OT win last week thanks to a wild 4Q that ended with kicker Aubrey nailing a 64-yarder to force OT. We weren't impressed considering the Cowboys were nearly TD home favorites. Speaking of not impressed, the Bears followed up their disastrous MNF 4Q vs Minnesota with an even more embarrassing blowout loss to the Lions. The Minnesota performance looked even worse considering the Vikings followed it up with a bad loss to the Falcons. Neither team is trust-worthy here. We've seen a ton of support for the OVER but we lean UNDER at current.

**SAN FRANCISCO 23 Arizona 20.** Both teams come in at 2-0. Both teams are +0.6 in yards per play margin. We've been a little more impressed with San Francisco despite all the injuries. The 49ers grabbed a couple of road wins and last week did so with Mac Jones (26 of 39 for 279 yards and 3 TD's). Arizona led Carolina 27-3 but nearly blew the big lead late in a 27-22 win. We like the 49ers here.

**Kansas City 25 N.Y. GIANTS 21.** Both teams are desperate at 0-2. Both teams suffered tough 3-point losses last week. The Chiefs fell at home to the Eagles. The key play being an interception on 2nd and Goal at the Philadelphia 6-yard line. The Eagles returned it 41 yards which led to a TD drive and instead of a possible 17-13 lead, KC found themselves down 20-10 in the fourth quarter. Speaking of fourth quarters, the Giants and Cowboys combined for 41 4Q points with Dallas getting a 64-yard FG to force OT. Then the teams didn't score at all until the final play of OT. KC is better in the stats (+0.5 vs -0.3) and certainly the more trusted commodity. However, something seems off about this year's team and were not laying 6 on the road. Especially if NYG QB Wilson can play like he did last week (30 of 41 for 450 yards and 3 TD's).

### **Monday, September 22nd**

**BALTIMORE 28 Detroit 24.** A lot of money coming in on the OVER here. Considering Baltimore has put up 40 and 41 points so far and the Lions put up 52 on the Bears last week, color us not surprised. Despite 1-1 records, both rank in the Top 7 in yards per play margin. Both coaches have been very profitable. We tend to lean with the Lions here as we prefer Harbaugh as a dog while Campbell thrives in the dog role.
