

Well Water & Septic Systems

Most homes in Sedalia use wells and septic systems and both require periodic maintenance and inspection. Whether you're new to owning these systems or just need a refresher, here are some resources for their maintenance.

Wells

The CDC has resources for keeping your well water safe: cdc.gov/drinking-water It's recommended to test your well water once a year for:

Bacteria, pH, Dissolved Solids, Nitrates, Chemicals, and Germs

Septic Systems

You need to know when to pump your tank; NCSU Extension provides a helpful guide at: https://content.ces.ncsu.edu/septic-systems-and-their-maintenance

You'll need to know your own system and usage for an accurate measure of when you should pump your tank, but here's a general guide that can give you a starting point based on tank size and number of users to gauge pumping frequency (in years).

Tank Size (gallons)	1	2	4	6	8	
900	11	5	2	1	<1	
1,000	12	6	3	2	1	
1,250	16	8	3	2	1	
1,500	19	9	4	3	2
