On March 8-11, the Community Life Center will be filled with over 100 judged quilts in a free exhibit sponsored by two Alamance County quilt guilds. Hours are 10:00 am to 6:00 pm on weekdays (Wednesday through Friday) and 10:00 am to 4:00 pm on Saturday. A whole new array of handmade projects will be on display, including 6 entries made by two of our church members! This is the second year ECC will be hosting the event, which helps us meet our Visioning Goal of bringing art into the Elon community. Admission is free, but we are asking that visitors bring canned goods to donate. Last year, ECC's Board of Missions & Outreach delivered over 900 pounds of food to the Salvation Army food pantry from this event, as well as a check for over \$1330, thanks to the generosity of our 600+ visitors to the show! Community Storyhealing Workshop March 29, Wednesday 5:30-8:30

Story-healing towards intergenerational peace and empowerment with Camilo Romero

Conflict and its collective resolution applies to each of our families and all of our communities, especially in these times of pandemics and politics. Each of us carries trauma from our own lives and that of generations before us. Our workshop is an opportunity to explore creative and interactive methods of rage and reconciliation, resentment and resilience. Our workshop will center around community building through story-telling. We will begin with introductions of each participant and explain the origins of ReGeneración (www.regeneracion.co) as a movement for empowerment of those who have been invisibilized for generations. We will then discuss our children's book project and form small groups to act out "sociodramas", spontaneous performances that challenge us to utilize all parts of our selves to identify, confront, and resolve conflicts within our environment. Our workshop is meant to be collaborative as each of us are experts in our story. Welcome. *Dinner included. Solar Panel Update: February was a good month for our solar panels; they produced 2.01 MWh of energy! Since they started in January 2019, they have produced a total of 136 MWh. That has saved us \$14,546.39 and prevented 210,700.5 pounds of carbon dioxide from being released into the atmosphere. That's equivalent to planting 1,592 trees! Yay, panels!
