For post game achievements, make notes during the game if needed. 3. "Constant" Achievements are the same on EVERY list, the rest vary list to list. 4. A complete round is from the start of someones turn until the start of their next turn. 5. CONSTANT (M)	*3*	It just keeps going and going and going... <small>Energizer Bunny (TV Commercial, 1989-?)</small>	<i>Either take a turn of 5+ minutes or take more than 1 extra turns/phases in a row (-1pt per extra turn/phase)</i>	-1pt						
	4	Bogus. Heinous. Most non-triumphant <small>Bill & Ted's Excellent Adventure (Movie, 1989)</small>	<i>Eliminate a player prior to their 5th turn (-4pts PER player you eliminate BEFORE their 5th turn)</i>	-4pts						
	5	Ha ha! You fool! You fell victim to one of the classic blunders - the most famous of which is "Never get involved in a land war in Asia" <small>The Princess Bride (Movie, 1987)</small>	<i>At each turn's cleanup step, lose 1pt for each land you destroyed this turn, BEYOND the first land you destroyed this turn (THIS DOES NOT USE THE STACK)</i>	-Xpts						
ONLY ONCE PER ROUND (1)	1	After careful consideration, I've decided NOT to endorse your park <small>Jurassic Park (Movie, 1993)</small>	<i>Be the first player to take damage from a Dinosaur OR to destroy a Dinosaur</i>	1pt						
	2	Do you pick Giant Douche or Turd Sandwich? <small>South Park (TV Series, 1997-?)</small>	<i>Be the first player to play a card which requires players to vote (ie: Will Of The Council or Council's Dilemma)</i>	1pt						
	3	He's an angry elf <small>Elf (Movie, 2003)</small>	<i>Be the first player to deal damage with an Elf</i>	1pt						
	4	It just so happens that your friend is only mostly dead <small>The Princess Bride (Movie, 1987)</small>	<i>Be the first player to return a creature to the battlefield from an opponent's graveyard</i>	1pt						
	5	Momma said they's my magic shoes <small>Forrest Gump (Movie, 1994)</small>	<i>Be the first player to cast either Lightning Greaves or Swiftfoot Boots (Bonus 1pt for ANYONE that casts Trailblazer's Boots)</i>	1pt

	7	The files are "IN" the computer <small>Zoosander* (Movie, 2001)</small>	<i>Be the first player to sacrifice/destroy an artifact to activate an ability, or as a result of an ability, of that SAME artifact (ie: Commander's Sphere, Nevinyrral's Disk, ...)</i>	1pt						
	8	What are we looking for, kids? - Sechs Dad. - That'll do Audrey <small>National Lampoon's European Vacation (Movie, 1985)</small>	<i>Be the first player to control a permanent with power, toughness, OR casting cost (NOT CMC) equal to 6 (there needs to be a "6" on the card)</i>	1pt						
	9	You're not here to kill me, I figured that out for myself <small>Terminator 2: Judgment Day (Movie, 1991)</small>	<i>Be the first player attacked by a creature with <0 power (At the declare attackers step) (The attacker also gets 1pt)</i>	1pt						
MULTIPLE TIMES (M)	10	I'm so three thousand and eight, you so two thousand and late <small>Boom Boom Pow - The Black-Eyed Peas (Music, 2009)</small>	<i>Play a card that has a NEW mechanic from a M:TG product released in the last 12 months (Only 1pt per mechanic) (Limit 3pts)</i>	1pt						
	11	We each owe a death - there are no exceptions <small>The Green Mile (Movie, 1999)</small>	<i>Eliminate a player that previously eliminated another player</i>	1pt						
ONLY ONCE TO EACH PLAYER (P)	12	Do you know what the pathetic thing is? You have been doing this your whole life <small>Happy Gilmore (Movie, 1996)</small>	<i>Eliminate a player that has been playing Magic longer than you (Before you start, determine when everyone started (ie: set, year, ...))</i>	1pt						
	13	I'd like to propose a toast... (Note: EACH player may do this only once per game, but points are cumulative) <small>Not Applicable</small>	<i>Make a toast in honor of your fallen creature (1pt to each player that takes a drink [from a container] to your toast, -1pt for those that don't) (Limit +/-2pts)</i>	Xpts						
	14	It's a bold strategy, Cotton <small>Dodgeball: A True Underdog Story (Movie, 2004)</small>	<i>Successfully choose the only player to not be eliminated (Before the game, each player secretly picks an OPPOSING player)</i>	2pts						
	15	There are some who call me ... Tim <small>Monty Python and the Holy Grail (Movie, 1975)</small>	<i>Use a creature to deal NON-COMBAT damage to any target (Bonus 1pt if you used an original art Prodigal Sorcerer)</i>	1pt						
M	16	Do NOT go in there! WHEW! <small>Ace Ventura: Pet Detective (Movie, 1994)</small>	<i>Get caught passing gas (group vote if needed) (belching is ok, unless it stinks) (Limit -6pts, have you seen a doctor?)</i>	-2pts
