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ADDENDUM

Do	Don't
Validate state licensing for the specific trade, if required.	Assume an individual or company has the appropriate license for the specific trade.
Verify appropriate insurance coverage for both liability and property damage. If no insurance, you may be liable.	Hire a contractor who only wants to be paid in cash.
Obtain and check out at least two recent references.	Hire a contractor who will not provide current references.
Verify no pending cases or complaints with the Attorney General's office, Better Business Bureau, and/or Office of Consumer Affairs.	Take shortcuts or make assumptions about the integrity of a contractor.
Decide precisely what you need/want to be done, and communicate this clearly to the contractor.	Neglect to express in detail your needs/tastes, priorities, timeframe, and budget for the work to be done.
Ask questions about all aspects of the work to be done.	Settle for less than satisfactory answers.
Talk to friends and neighbors about who they used, what they liked and didn't like, and what they wish they had known before selecting a contractor.	Take contractors at face value without checking out their claims or promises.
Obtain estimates from at least two contractors.	Take the lowest bid automatically.
Consider a background check if you have any questions at all.	Hire someone who solicits door to door.

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Do	Don't
Obtain a written quote/contract that includes the work to be done, total price, start and end dates, payment schedule (Deposit should not exceed one-third of total), who will obtain permits, if required, and guarantee.	Hire a contractor who wants to work on only a handshake agreement and wants to be paid the total sum for the job, or even a large portion, upfront. Also, allow work to begin prior to signing of the contract and transmittal of a copy to the owner.
Ask about availability of senior or other discounts.	Assume you're getting the best possible price.
Get names and cellphone numbers of primary and backup contractor contacts.	Assume that if a problem arises, it will be easy to contact the contractor.
Make final payment only after work is complete and you are completely satisfied with work done.	Assume contractor will do additional work once final payment is made.

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
