Dear Mr. Cook,

I am writing you with a great concern for justice and the safety of my family and myself. I would like to ask you to file the charges of Solicitation to Commit Murder against Charles A. Walls III. These charges should be filed because there is no reason that a man that planned to commit murder or oversee the murder of a father and a son should be allowed to walk free with no risk of punishment. I would also like to ask that you file charges for sexual solicitation on my behalf. I would like for these charges to be filed because of the incident between Jack Walls and I, on the night of December 29, 1992. No sexual charges were ever filed in my case and I would like to see that those charges are filed now.

I would also like to ask you to file any other possible charges at this time. The charging and prosecution of Charles A. Walls III will help the young people, that have been affected by his criminal activities, to deal with getting over these horrible events. If Jack Walls was shown for what he really is then maybe more people would come forward and the victims may someday lay these things to rest.

I would also like to ask you for an immediate response to this letter. I would like to know if you plan to file these charges? If you are planning to file these charges then when do you plan to do so? If you do not plan to file these charges then I need to know the maximum amount of time I have to get each charge filed? I also will need to know who or where I need to go to get these charges filed? I will give you a fair

time to see that these charges get filed and then I'll see about having these charges filed in another court. I would again like to ask you for an immediate response to this letter, including the answers to my questions. Four years ago, I took on the town, this time I am willing to take on the anyone to see that justice is served. I would like to thank you for your time and consideration. I hope to hear from you soon.
