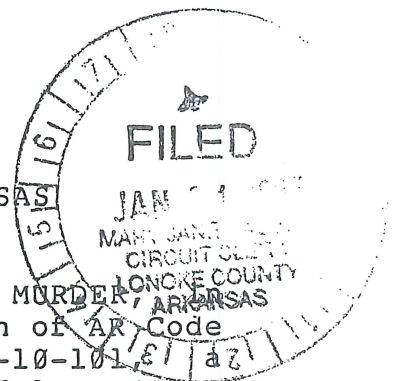
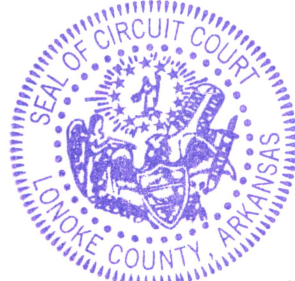

I N F O R M A T I O N

I, Larry Cook, Prosecuting Attorney within and for the
Seventeenth West Judicial District of the State of Arkansas, of
which Lonoke County is a part, in the name and by the authority of
the State of Arkansas, on oath, accuse the defendant of the crime
of CAPITAL MURDER committed as follows: on or about the 17th day
of January, 1997, in Lonoke County, Arkansas did unlawfully:

feloniously with the premeditated and deliberated purpose of
causing the death of another person caused the death of Joe
Stocks, or alteratively that the Defendant committed or
attempted to commit burglary and in the course and in the
furtherance of the felony he caused the death of Joe Stocks
under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the
value of human life, or alternatively that the defendant
committed robbery or attempted to commit robbery and in the
course and in the furtherance of the felony, he caused the
death of Joe Stocks under circumstances manifesting extreme
indifference to the value of human life, in violation of AR
Code Ann. 5-10-101; a Class Y felony.

AND

feloniously with the premeditated and deliberated purpose of
causing the death of another person caused the death of
Barbara Stocks, or alteratively that the Defendant committed
or attempted to commit burglary and in the course and in the
furtherance of the felony he caused the death of Barbara
Stocks under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to
the value of human life, or alternatively that the defendant
committed robbery or attempted to commit robbery and in the
course and in the furtherance of the felony, he caused the

death of Barbara Stocks under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, in violation of AR Code Ann. 5-10-101; a Class Y felony.

AND

feloniously with the premeditated and deliberated purpose of causing the death of another person caused the death of Heather Stocks, or alternatively that the Defendant committed or attempted to commit burglary and in the course and in the furtherance of the felony he caused the death of Heather Stocks under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, or alternatively that the defendant committed robbery or attempted to commit robbery and in the course and in the furtherance of the felony, he caused the death of Barbara Stocks under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, in violation of AR Code Ann. 5-10-101; a Class Y felony.


