INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

- 1. Activities: When Omaha schools are closed, Metro Women's Club functions are also canceled, ie. Bunco, Bridge etc.
- 2. **Luncheons:** When Omaha schools are closed our luncheons are canceled, <u>only if they are at a Restaurant</u>.
