

Actual Application



Did you know that you hear yourself speak more than anyone else hears you? Or that you believe yourself more than you believe others? Psalm 138:8, "The Lord will perfect that which concerns me; Your mercy, O Lord, endures forever; Do not forsake the works of Your hands."

Remember that old saying, practice makes perfect? God's Word is perfect. When you read/speak the Word out loud He promises to perfect it, that it won't go void, that faith comes by hearing and all this happens by hearing the Word of God.

The word practice means: the **actual application** or use of an idea, belief, or method.

He wants His Word to absorb you until His Word becomes perfected. He wants His Word to be a constant in your life. He wants His word to be an active, living, breathing part of you.

Just like when you eat something, it becomes a part of you! It brings life to your bones. When you speak the Word, it brings life to your spirit. Your spirit man is being fed the bread of life and it is eternal.

Friends, don't just meditate on what He has spoken to you, speak it out. Make His Words a living, breathing part you! Faith is built up and released through His Words (Mark 11:23-24).

When you speak God's Word it produces faith (Romans 10:17-18).

Speaking the Word is a venue through which you can receive from God (Romans 10:8-10, Matthew 4:4).

Speaking the Word is the best sword to fight the enemy with (Ephesians 6:17).
When you speak God's Word it sows God's truth into your hearts (Mark 4:14).

Remember, you alone are responsible for your tongue. Speak life to your situations! Don't let your tongue rule you. Let your tongue be ruled by the Word of God!
