Regular Meeting ----- June 11, 1992

The meeting was called to order by the Vice-ATTENDANCE Chairman, Gary Wilson at 7:00 A.M. at the District office. Other Board members present were Bobbie Domenick, and John Groo.

Special Service District members present were Gary Wilson, George White, and Dan Holyoak.

Bobbie Domenick moved to approve the minutes as MINUTES circulated to the board. George seconded.

Dale reported the dam inspection had taken place DAM INSPECTION and there are new regulations in the Dam Safety Act. The REPORT State Engineer may require monuments and pizometers to check for shifting, sinking and dam saturation. This would cost approximately \$30,000.00. The spillway may have to be repaired. These costs were discussed, along with funding available through the Division of Resources. The legislature has made this law retroactive and provided no funding for the problems. It has been suggested letters be written to legislators to try to set up a fund to take care of these financial responsibilities.

Bobbie moved to appoint Roberta as records officer RECORDS OFFICE for the Grand County Water Conservancy District. John seconded. MOTION CARRIED. George moved to appoint Roberta as Records Officer for the Grand County Special Service Water District. Dan seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

George moved to approve the checks. Bobbie CHECK APPROVAL seconded.

Gary read the proposed agreement with Sunrise En-SUNRISE ENG. gineering. The agreement was discussed AND SIGNED. AGREEMENT

Gary adjourned the meeting at 7:35 and asked those ADJOURNMENT present to come back at 8:00 or 8:15 to meet with the Sunrise Engineers.
