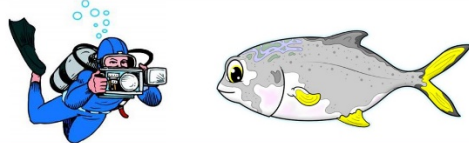

# Beginning Underwater Photography

It will cover basic principles that are applicable to both still and video. There will be an emphasis on how to shoot more satisfying images using the basic automatic settings and programs offered by modern products. The class will also include a discussion on the most popular equipment and on choosing cameras and accessories that meet the diver's needs and budgets. Following the two 3-hour class sessions there will be an opportunity for participants to try their cameras and cameras supplied by the sponsor in the pool and review their photos with the course instructor.
