STYLISTIC

Sewn Paint/Mixed Media

My signature style, in which I lay down multi-colored puddles of paint on a smooth, marble surface and allow them to cure. Once done, I sew designs and textures directly *into the paint* with a very specific shade of blue thread, which I call Moody Blue, and then reconstruct the individual pieces onto a painted canvas and coat it with resin to complete the larger piece.

Melted Layers

A technique I developed, in which I utilize a combination of acrylic paints, resins, and focused heat (in the form of a crème brûlée torch), which requires intense control and exact pigmentation placement, not dissimilar to the process and craftsmanship required for decorative glass blowing.

SKILLS

Painting: Acrylic on stretched canvas, plywood, and cardboard

Sewing: Hand sewing, mechanical sewing machines and multi-thread sergers

Resin & Torch: High gloss 2-part resins and crème brûlée torches

3-D Works / Sculpture: Clays and rolled, cured paint
